## **God's Perfect Timing and Faithfulness**

### **Highlighted Scripture**

**Genesis 1:1**

**In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.**

**Ecclesiastes 3:11**

**God has made everything beautiful in its proper time. He has placed eternity in the human heart, yet we cannot fully understand all that He has done from beginning to end.**

**Galatians 4:4–5**

**When the fullness of time had come, God sent His Son, born of a woman and under the law, to redeem those under the law so that we might receive adoption as His children.**

### **Discussion Questions**

- **What does it mean to you that God exists outside of time but works within it?**
- **How does understanding "the fullness of time" change how**

**you view delays in your own life?**

- **Why is it sometimes difficult to trust God when His timing doesn't match your expectations?**
- **How can remembering past moments of God's faithfulness strengthen your trust today?**
- **What role does gratitude play in helping you endure difficult seasons?**

### **Reflection Challenge**

**This week, focus on surrendering control of timing to God.**

**Ask yourself:**

- **Where am I trying to rush something God may be asking me to wait on?**
- **Am I trusting God's process, or just looking for His results?**
- **Can I remain faithful even when I don't see immediate answers?**

**Try this:**

- **Identify one situation where you feel impatient or uncertain**
- **Pray daily: "God, I trust Your timing even when I don't understand it"**
- **Reflect on a past situation where God worked things out better than you expected**

**Remember**

- **God created time—He is never rushed or late**

- **Jesus came at the exact right moment in history**
- **Waiting seasons are not wasted seasons**
- **God's faithfulness is often clearest in hindsight**
