Highlighted Scripture

- **Ephesians 4:15**

Believers are instructed to speak the truth in love, growing together into maturity in Christ.

- **Galatians 6:1–2**

Those who are spiritually mature are to gently restore those who have fallen and help carry one another's burdens.

- **Mark 10:42–45**

Jesus teaches that true leadership is demonstrated through humble service rather than seeking power or authority.

- **John 13:13–15**

Jesus sets the example of servant leadership by washing His disciples' feet and calling His followers to serve one another.

Discussion Questions

- Which of Tony's four leadership principles stands out to you the most? Why?
- Why is speaking truth with love more effective than simply pointing out someone's faults?
- What is the difference between confronting a problem and attacking a person?
- How did Jesus demonstrate servant leadership throughout His ministry?
- Whether you lead in your family, workplace, church, or community, how can you reflect Christ's leadership this week?

Reflection Challenge

Intentionally practice Christlike leadership wherever God has placed you.

Ask yourself:

- Am I leading others through humility and service or through control and frustration?
- Do people know I genuinely care about them before I offer correction?
- Am I reacting emotionally to problems, or responding with wisdom and grace?

Try this:

- **Encourage someone before offering constructive feedback.**
- **Spend time learning about someone you lead so you can better understand their needs.**
- **When conflict arises, address the issue without attacking the person's character.**
- **Ask God each morning to help you lead with humility, wisdom, and love.**

Remember

- **Christlike leadership begins with serving others.**
- **Truth is most effective when it is spoken with love.**
- **Strong leaders build relationships before offering correction.**
- **Wise leaders address problems without tearing people down.**
- **Jesus remains the perfect example of humility, compassion, and servant leadership.**
