Highlighted Scripture

Romans 6:1–4

“What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound? By no means! How can we who died to sin still live in it?”

Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?

We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.”

2 Corinthians 5:17

“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.”

Discussion Questions

- **What does it mean to be “dead to sin” but still struggle with sin in daily life?**
- **How does baptism symbolize our identification with Christ’s death and resurrection?**

➤ **In what ways can we live out our “new life” in practical, everyday decisions?**

➤ **Why is it important to remember our identity in Christ when we feel discouraged?**

➤ **How can we resist the lies that say we haven’t really changed?**

Reflection Challenge

Take time to reflect on what it means to truly live as a new creation in Christ.

Ask yourself:

➤ **Am I still identifying with my old self, or am I living in my new identity in Christ?**

➤ **Where am I allowing sin to have influence that it no longer has authority over?**

➤ **How can I actively choose to walk in newness of life each day?**

Try this:

Remind yourself daily that you are a new creation in Christ

When tempted, pause and remember that sin no longer defines you

Choose one area of your life to intentionally walk in obedience this week

Remember

In Christ, you are no longer defined by your past

Baptism represents a new life, not just a moment

Sin no longer has power over those who belong to Christ

Your identity is found in who Christ says you are

Prayer

Father God,

Thank You for the new life You have given through Jesus Christ.

Help me to walk in that newness each day and not return to my old ways.

Remind me of my identity in You when I am tempted or discouraged.

Give me strength to live in obedience and confidence in who You have made me to be.
