## **No One Is Too Far Gone**

**Speaker: Stacy Hazelwood**

**Main Passage: John 3:16–21**

**Highlighted Scripture (KJV):**

**John 3:16 – "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."**

### **Summary:**

**In this heartfelt message, Stacy Hazelwood shares his personal reflections sparked by recent news and a long-standing promise to step out of his comfort zone and speak up. Through his testimony, he draws attention to John 3:16–21, emphasizing the truth that no one is beyond the reach of God's love and redemption. He shares his past connection with secular music culture and reflects on the possibility of transformation—even for someone famously nicknamed "Prince of Darkness."**

**The central takeaway: If someone like Ozzy Osbourne could have turned to Jesus, then anyone can. God's mercy is deep, and His grace is available to all who believe.**

### **Discussion Questions:**

- **What stands out to you most in Stacy's testimony?**
- **How does John 3:16–21 encourage you to view your own past?**

- **Why do you think some people resist the light, as mentioned in verses 19–20?**
- **Have you ever delayed stepping out of your comfort zone like Stacy? What helped you overcome it?**
- **How can we better support others who feel “too far gone” to be loved by God?**

### **Reflection Challenge:**

**Take time this week to reflect on someone you think is “too far gone.” Pray for them. Ask God to help you see them through His eyes of redemption—and be willing to share the light.**

### **Prayer Prompt:**

**“Father, thank You that no one is beyond Your reach. Help me to trust in the power of Your light and love. Give me boldness like Stacy to share the truth, even when I’m uncomfortable. And may I never forget that You came not to condemn, but to save. Amen.”**
