Youth Alive Leadership

- **Core Leaders**

- Ideal to have 4 Core Leaders, one for each week (see description below)

- **Team Players**

- Active participating students who help Youth Alive with odd ends, lead by example, committed and strongly invites others.
 - They include but are not limited to roles like:
 - Campus Missionary
 - Church Representative
 - Worship Leader
 - Grade/ Sport / Area of School Rep.
 - Prayer Group Leader
 - Event Coordinator

- **MVP's (Most Valuable Players)**

- A different person selected by a Core Leader each week who is asked to help in leading YA that week. This helps involve many and they feel proud to help and be a part of YA!

→ The goal is to have four core leaders, one for each week, who share the responsibilities of the whole Youth Alive, but also delegate other responsibilities to other students so everyone takes pride or ownership in the club. Everyone is IMPORTANT! ←

Youth Alive Student CORE LEADER DESCRIPTIONS

Student Relations Leader:

- Coordinates or speaks for Week 1 -INCLUDE (small groups)
- Have MVP help each week
- Keep Records, attendance, visitor cards
- Follow-Up on visitors (call, text, or give YA gifts)
- In charge of providing food (if applies)

Student Life Leader:

- Schedules guest speakers for Week 2 - INSPIRE
- Have MVP help each week
- Advertising, Posters & Social Media
- Do School Announcements
- Plan Activities and Parties
- Communicate with churches about YA times, activities & outreaches



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Youth Alive Student CORE LEADER DESCRIPTIONS

Student Action Leader:

- Coordinates or Speaks for Week 3 – INVOLVE (student, youth leader, testimony)
- Have MVP help each week
- In charge of approving and getting any sound equipment, etc.
- Plan Fundraising
- Help plan activities & parties with Student Life Leader
- Recruit people to be Team Players (give them jobs)

Student Missions Leader:

- Coordinates & Schedules Week 4 – INVEST (outreach, gospel presentation)
- Have MVP help each week
- Serve as official YA representative or contact person to all school administration
- Talk to principal when needed
- **Main Leader of all Core Leaders (Important to designate this position, not that one is more important than others, just need to have a main leader to direct the team.**
- Coordinates communication between all YA Leaders, plans & meets with YA core leaders
- Keeps the mission, vision and goals focused.

ALL Leaders:

- Live a faithful, consistent Christian life
- Attend all meetings with YA Coach & other schools (once a month)
- Turn in "How's it Going" report to YA Coach at each meeting
- Commit to meet with your school's Leadership Team at other times.
- Give 100% in your area!
- Pursue personal opportunities to present Jesus Christ at school!

NOTE: Just as all schools are different; all campus clubs are different. You may need to adapt this information to best apply to your situation, but we strongly suggest that you use this Strategy and YA Student Leadership Strategy as the backbone of your campus club.
