

YOUTH ALIVE'S GOAL AND PURPOSE:

- To encourage and challenge Christian students to live for Christ.
- To give non-Christian students a chance to hear a clear presentation of who Jesus Christ is.

ICEBREAKER

Simple, creative idea to introduce subject. Like the headline of a news article that helps catch the attention of your audience. Could be a game or activity to create conversation.

MESSAGE

Find and study a devotional (from a devotional book, YouVersion, online, past sermon, etc.) and look up the related Bible verses. Think thru the overall theme and then in 10-15 minutes present your findings. Add a music video, video clip or the verse of the day clip that may add to your topic. Take the time each week to study and become familiar with the devo. If you do, you'll deliver with confidence. Go for it!

CHALLENGE TO APPLY

After the devotional message, challenge the students with an action step or how to apply it to their lives. Review the main points and challenge students to practice what was "preached".

SALVATION APPEAL

You probably will not need a salvation appeal after every meeting. Remember, however, that one of the reasons for your club is to win unbelievers for Christ. As the Holy Spirit leads you, challenge your friends to know Christ.
