

Sermon Guide WEEK 12

Read: Acts 11:19 - 14:29

Consider:

When most of us think of missionaries, we think of someone living overseas in an impoverished country, walking the streets every day, and telling people the good news. While that is a very real situation, this is not the only Christian missionary. Paul would argue that every one of us has the call to die to ourselves, take up our crosses, and live for our neighbor every single day. This is the life of a missionary.

Engage:

- 1. Why are missionaries essential to the church?
- 2. How do we evangelize well?

Practice:

Every morning, wake up and ask yourself a simple question: Who needs to hear about the ways God has worked in my life?

Apply:

Find one person this week and share with them something you have been walking through recently and how you have seen God move in that situation.

Ask:
