
This book is interactive, look for the links and QR codes in which you can watch embedded videos and find out more information about many of our partners and their projects.

- We always leave a reserve of funds available throughout the year for special opportunities that arise. In 2025, we were able to access those funds to provide for emergency needs for our missions partners here and around the world. These reserves are replenished regularly through your generous giving and our corporate tithing.

#### **CR AT GRACE: \$12,000**

Celebrate Recovery is a vital and thriving ministry here at Grace. CR offers a place of community and accountability to those struggling with all kinds of hurts, habits, and hang ups. We are thankful to see so many people growing in their relationship with God because of this ministry.





#### **SUMMER INTERNS: \$10,000**

Next summer we are looking to host interns again! These interns will most likely be college-aged young adults who desire to follow Jesus and be involved in the Church. They will be able to assist our church in some of the day-to-day operations, as well as assist the pastoral staff in some specific ministry objectives. Our relationship with these interns will be mutually beneficial as we will help prepare them for their future wherever God leads them. This allows our church and staff to disciple future leaders.

#### **OUTREACH FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS: \$4,000**

We are excited to work with Friends Around the World to share hospitality and, ultimately, the Gospel with the hundreds of international students enrolled at YSU each year. This is an awesome and unique mission opportunity right at our front door! These funds will be used to host meals and provide transportation to events, meals, and church. Also, because of the generosity of our church, we were able to distribute 108 backpacks to those needing them! It was a sweet event connecting with families, allowing volunteers to serve in a different capacity and kicking off our school year in a positive

As a result of the wonderful giving our church family, this was a twofold event. We were able to distribute 60 gift boxes to the teachers at Niles Primary School and Crossroads Residential school, as a thank you and prayer for the time they pour into the children they serve! Grace Fellowship Church also stocked the snack pantry at Niles Primary to allow them to accommodate any hunger needs at the start of school.

#### An update from Zack Potter:

Grace family,

This January will mark 4 years since we launched out of Grace and moved into Winter Haven with faith and vision from God. We are so thankful for your support over the years- prayerfully and financially!

Lakeside will officially turn 3 years old in January, and I'm so thankful for what the Lord is doing. At the start of this year we were averaging about 60 people in attendance, we had 4 small groups (with 10 leaders leading those groups) with about 40 of our people committing themselves to being discipled, and roughly \$11,000 in monthly offerings. Our prayerful desire was to become self-sustained by the end of this year, which would require doubling everything within the year. As of today when I'm typing this (just before October) God has done more than double everything! Praise the Lord! What a year it has been!

As of today we have over 150 people that call Lakeside home, we have 8 small groups (28 leaders) with about 100 people being discipled, and we are averaging over \$23,000 in monthly offerings. We also started a youth ministry in the summer and have a youth pastor that is meeting weekly with students in small groups and having outreach events every other month. We had 40 students in our first youth gathering! We had our 2nd annual VBS, which averaged about 30 children each night, and had plenty of volunteers to help out- last year we needed help from another church to even do VBS, so this was our first official on our own. We have many guests every Sunday and they are choosing to align their lives with Lakeside. We are growing on a weekly basis as a church right now. We have also had several salvations this year and will have baptisms soon to celebrate that! We also have 8 young adults that are called into full time ministry that I will be personally discipling throughout next year!

On top of all of this there are things that are difficult to quantify, but demonstrate how God is working in people's lives. Last year we committed to being a House of prayer for all nations. We wanted to focus as a church on making prayer our priority- personally and collectively. We have intentional time of prayer in every worship service and in our small groups. We have a prayer team and prayer leaders that meet early on Sunday to pray for an hour before worship service begins. I believe God is hearing and answering our prayers. We have seen a church member healed of cancer, a husband who hadn't been to church attending the worship service and going to small group with his wife, relationships in homes reconciled, brokenness healed, and a people that are truly hungry for God to move in our lives and county.

I recognize that none of what God is doing would be possible without you. Your support, love, prayers and financial gifts have allowed us to "put our hands to the plow" and focus on the ministry He has called us to do. Planting a church is difficult work, but work that we are pleased to do for Christ. We have to till the hard soil for a while before we can plant seeds and see them grow. Our first two years involved tilling hard soil and planting seeds primarily. I am starting to see the fruit grow. There are more stories, more life change, more salvations, more healing, and more transformation that will come and your continued partnership will allow us to rejoice in a great harvest together!

You have fruit in Central Florida, Grace. So thankful for all of you.

#### SMALL CIRCLE: \$500 A MONTH

SmallCircle is an app that is making a huge discipleship impact in more than 100 countries already! You can download the app for free and start a discipleship journey with a friend in your life. In the past we have helped translate these resources into other languages or make trainings happening in various locations. Small Circle is growing, and we get to be a part.

#### Update from Small Circle creator:

"I announced to our church family a couple of months ago that my wife and I have sensed God's call for us to be full-time missionaries through the work of SmallCircle. To give an idea, we've just trained in Chicago, Boston, and London and in the next two months, we'll train in Portugal, Germany, France, Argentina, and Guatemala. We are now asking the Lord to bring those who are led to partner with consistent monthly support. We are looking for churches to support at \$500 a month."



# CLEVELAND, CRU: \$4,000 ONE-TIME GIFT MONTHLY SUPPORT: \$385 A MONTH

Aaron and Katie Golby serve with Cru, reaching students on college campuses in Cleveland and Northeast Ohio. They build and equip Christians to be witnesses for Christ on campus, and to mobilize and send out the next generation to all nations as disciple-makers for the rest of their lives.

#### Check out this update from the Golbys:

"Last year we reached the limit at the camp we've been using for our annual Cru Northeast Ohio fall retreat. To keep up with the growth of our ministries, we need to move to a bigger camp. But a bigger camp comes with greater costs.

Fall Retreat is a weekend where new Christian students begin to view themselves as ambassadors for Christ on campus. Students who are not Christians hear the gospel throughout the weekend and see it lived out in Christian community. Through last year's fall retreat a student named Emily became a Christian. Now, almost a year later she's an intern on our ministry team, equipped in evangelism and discipleship and reaching even more non-Christian students just like she was.

This funding would enable us to reduce the price to make it affordable for students so we can have the biggest possible impact and reach the most students possible. For us to get several hundred students to a weekend filled with biblical teaching, worship, and godly community, we need \$6,000."







Emily's story: Cru ministry intern, 2025 graduate of John Carroll University

Last fall, Ian, one of our student leaders at John Carroll University (JCU) texted his classmate, Emily. Ian invited Emily to the Cru Bible study. Emily came to the Bible study. A few days later, Ian and Gabe, another student leader, met with Emily and shared the gospel with her. Over the course of a few days, Emily read the book, The Case for Christ. A few weeks later she came to our Cru Fall Retreat.

On Saturday night of the retreat, Ian, Gabe, and Aaron were praying for Emily. An hour later, Emily texted Ian and Gabe, "I think I had my religious Aha! moment!"

Emily became a Christian that weekend, and became a core

Emily became a Christian that weekend, and became a core part of Cru at JCU. Now, almost a year later, she is an intern with Cru in Northeast Ohio. She is equipped in discipleship and evangelism, and spends her days reaching out to lost college students just like she was.







The new location is one block from the current space. This renovation will allow Morgan Grace Church to have a max capacity of 260 people.

#### UTAH, MORGAN GRACE CHURCH ONE-TIME GIFT: \$5,000 MONTHLY SUPPORT: \$385 A MONTH

Morgan is nestled in the Wasatch Mountain Range in rural, northern Utah. Morgan County is one of the spiritually darkest places in the modern world. In a 2010 survey, there were zero professing evangelical Christians in the county of roughly 12,000 people. Chase Roberts moved to Utah in 2020, and his brother, Gavin, followed in 2021. Starting with just three families, Morgan Grace Church has now grown to be a body of over 120 believers. This church has seen many families leave the local, dominant religion and come to a saving faith in the Jesus of the Bible.

#### Check out this update from Chase & Gavin Roberts:

"We currently have a seating capacity of 155 chairs. Over the last few weeks, we have had 120+ attendees. Our space problem will be alleviated with the renovation of our new building. Our new location is planned to seat roughly 210 individuals. Current estimates are \$700,000 for the project. This building is a block from our current location on the main street in Morgan. For the first time in the history of our town, an evangelical church owns property!

The new space will have space for a nursery, kids space, and a large kitchen for our fellowship meals. In addition to the 210 chairs that will fit in the worship area, our movable wall between worship and fellowship areas will add roughly 50 seats to increase our max capacity to 260 for future growth and larger events."

#### MEXICO, BELLAS PREGNANCY CRISIS CENTER: \$10,000





In Queretaro, Mexico, Bellas Pregnancy Center exists to support women facing unplanned pregnancies with care, information, and resources—always centered in Christ and life. They will offer biblical counseling, resources, education, post-abortion recovery and education in schools about the value of life. This will be the first pregnancy crisis clinic in this region of Mexico. These funds will help them get closer to opening their doors!

#### **REACH MINISTRIES: \$400 A MONTH**



We are continuing to monthly support the work of Reach Ministries. This organization focuses on spreading the gospel through their work in **Yucatan villages**, a children's home in **Jamaica** and spreading the gospel through church networks in **Egypt**.

#### **BRAZIL, EXPANSION AT VINDE MENINOS: \$10,000**



The teens who join the Vinde Meninos program carry a heavy weight far beyond their years. Many face constant pressure from their families to find work and contribute to the household budget—even while still in the early years of high school. This reality often forces them to make heartbreaking choices: leaving the Vinde program, dropping out of school, and taking any job they can find. Without proper training or guidance, these young people lose the chance to build real skills, discover a vocation, and prepare for a future filled with opportunities.

With your help, these teens don't have to trade education for survival. You can give them the tools, training, and hope they need to step into adulthood prepared—not just for work, but for life. To help these students achieve success, we are excited to announce the creation of the VINDE MENINOS YOUTH SKILL AND MENTORSHIP PROGRAM. Together, we can build the Vinde Meninos Training Center— a safe and inspiring space where teens can learn a trade, receive professional guidance, and prepare for the job market with dignity and hope.

At our property, we already have many of the facilities needed for a trade school. In phase one of our Vinde Meninos Trade Center project we want to add a 1,000 sq. ft. building dedicated to teaching electrical installations, metalwork and woodworking skills.

Summer 2026 Estimated Cost: \$2,500

We will primarily be working with kids each day, sharing devotions, skits, music and soccer camps.

#### **DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, NEW MISSIONS: \$2,500**

New Missions works in many areas of Latin America strengthening churches, offering quality education and touching poverty. They currently have a need to purchase a storage container for their Dominican Republic center to ship supplies and then later to use for storage and distributing school supplies and Christmas gifts to their students.



#### **MEXICO, CONNEXUS GLOBAL: \$3,000**

Connexus Global is all about developing leaders and changing lives internationally by sharing the Gospel through the vehicle of business development.

#### Training Pastors & Church Leaders in San Luis, Mexico: \$3,000

Connexus Global has the opportunity to expand training deep into Mexico. Connexus will host a two-day pastor and church leadership training in San Luis, Mexico. These funds will help provide all training materials and food for those attending the conference. The attendees will be groups from multiple mission's agencies and pastor's networks.

Care4More, currently led by James Melton, has been serving the Filipino people since 1987. Care4More consists of a Bible college, a Christian school, churches, meal programs, a home for single mothers, and the Hope Alive Clinic where women can receive free medical care throughout their pregnancies and deliveries.

This year we will be adopting Bible college or seminary students to prepare for a life of ministry for \$500 U.S. per semester, including tuition, room, and board.

#### SENDING MISSIONARIES: \$7,000 MONTHLY SUPPORT: \$350 A MONTH



Connect Global is a missions mobilization ministry that challenges, engages and mobilizes churches to send new missionaries from Latin America. This year they are sending six Latin American missionaries to **India, Nepal, and Bangladesh.** They will be joining other mission teams alredy working in these different areas. To send all six, Connect Global is raising \$18,000.



#### **MYANMAR, MINISTRY SUPPORT: \$4,000**

For many years we have supported this work in Myanmar where there is currently civil unrest, war, and extreme poverty. Elvis Sado is a church planter and supports many poor and needy people, including the orphan children at the Grace Home. This project money will go towards continuing to sustain this ministry.

# ROMANIA, INTL ACCESS TO MISSIONS: \$5,000 ONE-TIME GIFT MONTHLY SUPPORT: \$350 A MONTH

#### **ITALY, CITY HOUSE: \$3,000**

**Jon and Becky Liles** are church-planting missionaries in Italy. They surrendered to Italy knowing that the work is slow and difficult. Their current focus is the Castelli Romani, a group of 17 beautiful towns just outside of Rome where more than 250,000 precious people reside. These towns are close enough to Rome for work, but far enough away that families can raise their children in a typical Italian village setting. Although they have lived and worked in this part of Rome since 2008, the Liles are now specifically focusing on connecting with their community through City House Rome, a community hub and coffee house. This ministry is strategically positioned on a major road in Grottaferrata where the Liles originally started. So far, City House has been used for Bible studies, prayer meetings, youth events, and community meetings. They have added after school programs for kids, English language learning, and community projects that bring these cities together to serve families in need. These funds will help aid their continued ministry.

#### PORTUGAL, THE ZEIGLERS **ONE-TIME GIFT: 3,000 MONTHLY SUPPORT: \$500 PER MONTH**

An update from Tommy and Courtney Zeigler, our missionaries to Portugal.

"Our focus is the Portuguese Baptist Convention, which has 78 churches but only 65 pastors. These congregations are where most native Portuguese believer's gather, and many are without consistent shepherding. Our vision is to see future pastors emerge from flourishing local churches where discipleship is a way of life. By cultivating hospitality, mentoring, and daily obedience, we want our local partner church to grow into a hub for training and sending leaders, so that the priesthood of believers is equipped and the churches of Portugal are shepherded well.

We cannot do this alone. We need your prayers and partnership to remain here in this work, and we would be glad to speak with anyone the Lord may be stirring to consider joining us long-term in Portugal. Together, we long to see the church strengthened and the gospel advanced for generations to come."

Pastor Elijah and Claudia Morar have been leading mission endeavors in Romania and throughout Europe for more than two decades with Partners in Missions International.

#### Here is an update from the Morars:

I greet you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, and I want to begin by expressing my deep gratitude for your faithful partnership in the ministry here in Romania. Your prayers, encouragement, and generous support over the years have been a testimony of God's love and provision. Because of your faithfulness, we have been able to reach children and families with the gospel, disciple them in the truth of God's Word, and demonstrate Christ's love in practical ways.

One of the most meaningful parts of our ministry is the Christian school that God has entrusted to us. This school has become a place of hope, learning, and transformation for children from many different backgrounds. Today, we have the privilege of teaching and sharing the gospel with Ukrainian, Gypsy, Palestinian, Israeli, Hungarian and Romanian children all under one roof. It is remarkable to see how God is bringing the nations to our doorstep, and He has given us the opportunity to sow seeds of His Word not only into the lives of these children, but also into the lives of their families.

As the ministry grows, so does the need to create more space and provide a safe, welcoming environment for our students. God has opened the door for us to remodel the school so that we can accommodate more children and provide them with the resources they need. By May of 2026, our goal is to complete the remodeling project, which includes finishing four classrooms, two sets of bathrooms, and the insulation of the roof to accommodate  $6\overline{5}$  more kids. To give you a clearer picture:

Insulation of the roof – \$5,500

Two sets of bathrooms (girls and boys) - \$3,500 each

Four classrooms (floors, walls, pews, and chairs) – \$4,500 each

This project is more than just about bricks, mortar, and furniture—it is about creating a space where the gospel can be shared, discipleship can take place, and children can learn and grow in a Christ-centered environment. Each classroom represents more children who will hear about Jesus. Each bathroom completed represents dignity and care for their wellbeing. The insulated roof represents a safe and warm place where they can study and worship together.

We know that such a vision is beyond what we can accomplish alone. But we also know that God has given us partners like you, who share in the calling to bring His truth to the nations. Your long-standing support has already helped us accomplish so much, and for that, we are truly thankful. We see you not just as supporters, but as co-laborers in Christ.

I want to encourage you to prayerfully consider standing with us once again in this important endeavor. First and foremost, we ask for your prayers—that God would continue to provide the resources, protect the children, and empower us to teach and disciple faithfully. Secondly, as the Lord leads, we invite you to support us financially so that together we can see this vision fulfilled. Every contribution, no matter the size, makes a difference in the lives of these children and their





# KENYA, WORLD HOPE FLOODING CRISIS: \$10,000

#### **CONTINUED MONTHLY SUPPORT: \$550 PER MONTH**

Pastor Roy has served on the board of **World Hope** for over 25 years. The longtime work that WH has done in Nairobi, Kenya has changed generations of families and pushed back the Kawangware slum that the thriving church and school is located at the edge of.

#### Check out this update from World Hope:

Hope Academy, located in a low-lying area of the Kawanguare slum , faces increasingly severe floods. The polluted river that flows right outside the walls of the school facility, routinely overflows during rains pushing contaminated water back onto our property.

The flooding is compounded by the reality that the

The flooding is compounded by the reality that the river flows with the sewage overflow from all of Kawangware slum. Contaminated water spreads into the dining hall and classroom block, directly endangering students' health where they eat and learn. The number one health issue we deal with in our students are the skin and parasite issues from the dirty water they have to deal with in their lives everyday. Frequency:

 Major floods occur during Nairobi's rainy seasons (March-May, October-December) but can follow any heavy rain.

Each flood halts school operations:

- 2-3 hours for water to recede
- 1–2 hours for sanitation and cleanup
- This results in repeated loss of valuable learning time and added sickness among students.

Flooding has driven away about 15% of our students due to health concerns, safety fears, and disruptions. Unless addressed urgently, retention will continue to decline.

To protect our students and restore confidence, we propose an immediate intervention.

1. Secure and waterproof the barrier wall with a 'Liquid Flexible Rubber Membrane', similar to what is used in pools and basement walls. Along with this we will use gravel, backfill and change the flow of how the water moves past our property. \$10,000

moves past our property. \$10,000
2. The second stage will be a New Drainage System –
Build a channel to divert stormwater and block sewage
backflow. Along with this we will devise holding tanks to
hold water when it floods to capture the ground waters
that move down toward the school on our property till
we can pump them into the sewer system at a rate that
the system can carry without overflowing and backfilling
into the school. \$8,000

Our plan is that this intervention will end the flooding into the school, remove health hazards, ensure uninterrupted learning, and stabilize enrollment. our children will know that World Hope Academy is at least the one place where they will be safe and secure during the rains

#### TRAINING EAST AFRICAN PASTORS: \$2,500

#### from Charles Macharia with Firm Foundations:

"East Africa is experiencing explosive church growth. This opportunity, however, presents a critical challenge. The growth in the number of believers has dramatically outpaced the development of mature, theologically grounded leaders capable of shepherding them. The consequences are severe: a rise in false teaching, nominalism, and spiritual immaturity that threatens the long-term health of the church. Our response is guided by a vision of empowering local leaders through a model of intentional, multiplying discipleship. Our program equips leaders in biblical foundations, pastoral character, and practical skills, with a core focus on training them to multiply the process in others. One pastor fully equipped and supported for an entire training cycle, ready to multiply disciples and transform their community costs \$450."

#### TANZANIA, THE BOONS, RENOVATIONS OF NEW PROPERTY: \$5,000

Grace has been a longtime supporter of the Boon family's ministry in Tanzania! They have several facets of their work: training local pastors, translating christian materials, career training, discipleship, food sustainability, and all of these work together to spread the Gospel.

#### Check out this update from Aaron & Stephanie Boon:

Thank you so much for reaching out and for your heart for our family and ministry. We are grateful for Grace's ongoing partnership in the gospel, and we're excited to share an important project for 2026.

As you may know, the property we had lived in and used for ministry for many years was taken from us when the landlord unexpectedly removed us. That was a difficult season, but God faithfully provided a new property that is already being used for multiple ministries:

- · Counseling and discipleship
- Sifa Collective (training young women with skills and Scripture)
- Bible Training Centre for Pastors (BTCP) classes
- 100 Fold Publishing of Swahili Christian books

And, Lord willing, it will one day be the home of a new church plant, hopefully by next summer if the funding comes together.

The biggest next step is completing the unfinished upstairs, which is strategically designed to include:

- Dormitory space for pastors and students attending BTCP intensives
- A media room for recording Christian Swahili podcasts and YouTube videos to reach across East Africa
- Offices for the teams serving daily in counseling, BTCP, publishing, and member care

There are six rooms upstairs, and each requires about \$5,000-\$7,000 to finish (plaster, windows, ceilings, electrical, flooring, and furnishings). Completing these spaces will give us a sustainable ministry hub for training, publishing, media, counseling, and church planting for years to come.

This project is both strategic and time-sensitive as BTCP continues to grow and more leaders are coming for training. Having dorms and a media hub ready will multiply the impact significantly.

Thank you again for considering how Grace might partner with us in this next season. We are so grateful for you and for Grace's heart for missions.

James & LaNelle have been serving in Ivory Coast for over 20 years. They are church planters, evangelists, and have a home for orphan girls. In the past we have done all kinds of missions projects with them such as purchasing new church land, new roofs, new motorcycles for a ministry they have, helping purchase a new van so they can transport the orphan girls to school, etc. We love this ministry!

#### **Update from James & LaNelle:**

Another school year has arrived at GAP Orphanage. We will have 28 girls in school this year which includes our 3 university students who plan to take one more year of courses. We take total charge of these children when they arrive at GAP Orphanage. Imagine having 28 children living in your home and you will have an idea of what we face on a daily basis.

With inflation, transport, school lunches, uniforms, books, athletics, and personal needs, the cost seems unreachable, but the Lord has always fulfilled HIS promise to care for orphans and HE has never let us down.

Grace Fellowship has always been a "first responder" when it comes to helping with school expenses. The need is greater this year than ever before because many of the girls are older and have advanced in their level of education. Plus, we just took on 9 more children, ages 7-9 years old this year.

God always works through the hearts of His people and I trust that HE will work again through the people of Grace Fellowship. May God abundantly bless in this year's missions month and make provision for all your hearts desire is my prayer.




