Then he showed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the Lord, and Satan standing at his right hand to accuse him. <sup>2</sup> And the Lord said to Satan, “The Lord rebuke you, O Satan! Is not this a brand plucked from the fire?” <sup>3</sup> Now Joshua was standing before the angel, clothed with filthy garments. <sup>4</sup> And the angel said to those who were standing before him, “Remove the filthy garments from him.” And to him he said, “Behold, I have taken your iniquity away from you, and I will clothe you with pure vestments.” <sup>5</sup> And I said, “Let them put a clean turban on his head.” So they put a clean turban on his head and clothed him with garments. And the angel of the Lord was standing by.

<sup>6</sup> And the angel of the Lord solemnly assured Joshua, <sup>7</sup> “Thus says the Lord of hosts: If you will walk in my ways and keep my charge, then you shall rule my house and have charge of my courts, and I will give you the right of access among those who are standing

here. <sup>8</sup> Hear now, O Joshua the high priest, you and your friends who sit before you, for they are men who are a sign: behold, I will bring my servant the Branch. <sup>9</sup> For behold, on the stone that I have set before Joshua, on a single stone with seven eyes, I will engrave its inscription, declares the Lord of hosts, and I will remove the iniquity of this land in a single day. <sup>10</sup> In that day, declares the Lord of hosts, every one of you will invite his neighbor to come under his vine and under his fig tree.” (ESV)
