



## The Holy Spirit - Part 4

### Baptism in the Holy Spirit pg 1

The Spirit of God desires to be your friend.

Acts 1:4-5 NKJV

And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, “which,” He said, “you have heard from Me; for John baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.”

John 20:22

“He breathed on them and said, ‘Receive the Holy Spirit’”

Acts 2:1-4 NKJV

When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.

Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one set upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and they began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 2:32-33 NKJV

This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses. Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear.

Acts 2:38-39

Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.”

Acts 8:12-16

When they believed Philip as he preached the good news of the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized [in water], both men and women. Simon himself believed and was baptized.

When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent Peter and John [to them]. (accepted the Word of God – sign of being born again)

Luke 11:13 NKJV

If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!

Acts 8:17-19 NKJV

Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit. And when Simon saw that through the laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Spirit was given, he offered them money, saying, “Give me this power also, that anyone on whom I lay hands may receive the Holy Spirit.”

Acts 9:4-6

“Saul! Saul! Why are you persecuting me?”

“Who are you Lord?” Saul asked. And the voice replied. “I am Jesus, the one you are persecuting! Now get up and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do.”

Acts 9:17 NKJV

“Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit.”



## The Holy Spirit - Part 4

### Baptism in the Holy Spirit pg 2

1 Corinthians 14:18

I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than you all; yet in the church I would rather speak five words with my understanding that I may also teach others, than ten thousand words in a tongue.

Acts 10:44-46

While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word. And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God.

Acts 19:2-6 NKJV

“Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?”

So they said to him, “We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit.” And he said to them, “Into what then were you baptized?” So they said, “Into John’s baptism.”

Then Paul said, “John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after Him, that is, on Christ Jesus.”

When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.

Acts 1:4-8

On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command, “Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about.

For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” Then they gathered around him and asked him, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?”

He said to them: “It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

**1. The primary sign of Baptism in the Holy Spirit is not tongues, it's power to share the Gospel.**

**2. The Holy Spirit baptized you into Christ which is Salvation when you personally believed in Jesus.**

1 Corinthians 12:14

For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, (The Holy Spirit's main role on the earth is to make Jesus known for Salvation)

Matthew 28:19

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

**3. A disciple baptizes us into water.**

**4. Jesus fills us with the Holy Spirit**

Matthew 3:11

I baptize you with water for repentance, but he who is coming after me is mightier than I, who sandals I am not worth to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.
