Language of the Holy Spirit pg 1

1 Corinthians 14:2 NKJV

μυστηρίω - *mysterion*

hidden or not fully understood yet, wisdom. Hidden from ungodly or wicked men.

1 Corinthians 2:7 NKJV

We speak the wisdom [or counsel] of God in a mystery...

1 Corinthians 2: 12-13 NIV

What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may understand what God has freely given us. This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, explaining spiritual realities with Spirit-taught words.

1 Corinthians 14:2 NKJV

For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries.

I pray in tongues not because I'm better than you.

I pray, sing, speak in tongues because I need God's hidden counsel to be better than me.

Psalm 89:7 NKJV

God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be held in reverence by all those around Him.

James 1:5 NKJV

If any of you lacks wisdom [about what to do], let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally.

Isaiah 48:17 NKJV

I am the Lord your God, Who teaches you to profit, Who leads you by the way you should go.

1. It keeps the enemy from knowing God's game plan to win battles against the enemy.

2. Intimacy with God. We can speak to God on His level not just on our own level.

3. It gives us the ability to draw out God's hidden wisdom for situation's we are facing.

4. It brings rest and refreshing to our bodies, soul, and spirit.

1 Corinthians 14:20-21 NKJV

Brethren, do not be children in understanding... In the law it is written: "With men of other tongues and other lips I will speak to this people..."

Isaiah 28:11-12 NKJV

For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people, To whom He said, "This is the rest with which You may cause the weary to rest," And, "this is the refreshing."

5. It builds our inner man. It makes me a better me.

1 Corinthians 14:4 NKJV

He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself...

Oikodomeo: literally, to construct or build

To build up your inner man's capacity to house the presence and power of God.

Matthew 7:24

Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock.

Jude 20-21 NIV

But you, dear friends, building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life.

6. It gives us the ability to give thanks on a much higher level.

1 Corinthians 14:16-17 NLT

For if you praise God only in the spirit, how can those who don't understand you praise God along with you? How can they join you in giving thanks when they don't understand what you are saying? You will be giving thanks very well, but it won't strengthen the people who hear you.

Mark 16:17 NLT

And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.

1. You must have already received Jesus Christ as your Lord and your Savior.

2. There cannot be a pattern of disobedience to God in your life.

3. Ask to receive the Holy Spirit.

4. You have to speak.

1. Yield your lips.

2. Yield your tongue.

3. Yield your vocal cords.
