

The Fight - Part 6 Training to Win 2.0

Hebrews 12:6-8 (NLT)

For the Lord <u>disciplines</u> those <u>he loves</u>, and he punishes each one he accepts as his child." As you endure this divine discipline, remember that God is treating you as his own children. Who ever heard of a child who is never disciplined by its father? If God doesn't discipline you as he does all of his children, it means that you are illegitimate and are not really his children at all.

<u>Discipline</u> is nothing something Jesus does to us, it's something Jesus does <u>for us</u>.

Training to Win 1.0

- 1. Start now.
- 2. Discipline for motivation not humiliation.
- 3. Don't give in or no one will win,
- 4. Punishment is part of discipline and the punishment should match the crime.
- 5. Call it tight and they'll get it right.
