

The Holy Spirit - Part 2

The Personality of the Holy Spirit

2 Corinthians 13:14

May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

Koinonia: fellowship, companionship, communication, intimacy, sharing together, partnership, joint participation, close mutual association.

1. Fellowship: a friendly relationship, companionship, sharing together

Acts 20:22-23 NLT

And now I am going to Jerusalem, drawn there irresistibly by the Holy Spirit, not knowing what awaits me, except that the Holy Spirit has told me in city after city that jail and suffering lie ahead.

Acts 10:19 NKJV

While Peter thought about the vision, the Spirit said to him, "Behold, three men are seeking you."

Acts 8:29 NKJV

The Spirit said to Philip, "Go near and overtake this chariot."

Acts 16:6-7 NKJV

Now when they had gone through Phrygia and the region of Galatia, they were forbidden by the Holy Spirit to preach the word in Asia. After they had come to Mysia, they tried to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit did not permit them.

2. Partnership

1 Corinthians 3:9 KJV

We are laborer's together with God.

Therefore take heed to yourselves, and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers.

Acts 13:2 NKJV

3. Intimacy

John 14:7

If you really knew me, you would know my Father as well.

1 Corinthians 7:40 NLT

But in my opinion it would be better for her to stay single, and I think I am giving you counsel from God's Spirit when I say this.

Genesis 1:27 NKJV

God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

Ephesians 4:30 NKJV

Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

Lupet – to be sad, sorrowful

Lupe – a pain or grief that can only be experienced from two people that deeply love each other.

Ephesians 4:29-32 NLT

Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them. And do not bring sorrow to God's Holy Spirit by the way you live. Remember, he has identified you as his own... Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior. Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you.

Matthew 12:32 NKJV

Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the age to come.
