

## Grace for the Nations

## Jonah 3:1-10

As a Life Group or Family:

- 1. Pray for one another.
- 2. Pray for those who don't know Christ by name.
- 3. Ask each other: "What has God done in your life this week?"
- 4. Ask each other: "What has God taught you this week?"
- 5. Ask each other: "Have you shared Jesus with anyone this week?"
- 6. How can you serve together as a group?

- 1. As a group, read Jonah 3:1-10 together.
- 2. A couple of weeks ago, we asked the question, "Has there ever been a time in your life when God called you to obey Him in a difficult thing?" When you look back at that time (or maybe God is calling you to obedience right now), would you say that you: A) Delayed obedience; B) Begrudgingly obeyed; C) Experienced a heart change and deepened faith and obeyed wholeheartedly?
- 3. What did God teach you about Himself and about yourself during that faith stretching call to obedience?
- 4. **GOD'S MISSION** is for His glory to be made known throughout the earth (including Montgomery!) by extending grace and forgiveness of sin to all nations (all people).

**GOD'S METHOD** of carrying out His mission is through believers. As a group, talk through the sermon points from this message and all of the ways God accomplished His mission through Jonah. What does this show us about how we can personally be involved in the mission of God?

5. Read Romans 10:13-18. Where is the breakdown in the mission of God?

(If those who are sent don't go). What does this say to us?
