BIBLE READING

Read: Genesis 18-19; Genesis 20-21; Genesis 22; Genesis 24; Genesis 25:19-34; Genesis 26

Memorize: Romans 4:20-22

PRAYER

Sunday, January 16 — *In Jeremiah's day, people often worshiped the works of their own hands (Jeremiah 1:16). Pray that Christians today will turn away from this temptation and will exalt the One who is at work within them both to will and to work for His own good pleasure (Philippians 2:13).*

Monday, January 17 — *Let's pause right now and heed the exhortation of the psalmist who wrote, "Come, let us worship and bow down, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker" (Psalm 95:6).*

Tuesday, January 18 — *Pray that people in your church will not be like the hypocrites who love to stand and pray in order to be seen by men (Matthew 6:5). Ask God to show any who may have this attitude that there is no eternal reward in that type of prideful praying.*

Wednesday, January 19 — *People often think they are too busy or life is too crowded for them to pray. For those you know who may think this way, ask God to show them that finding a quiet place for prayer was important to Jesus and should be to them as well (Mark 1:35).*

Thursday, January 20 — *Pray that your friends will be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, let their requests be made known to God (Philippians 4:6).*
