


Family Guide

What are your thoughts on the LGBTQIA2+ debate? (LGTBQIA2S+ is an acronym for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer and/or Questioning, Intersex, Asexual, Two-Spirit, and the countless affirmative ways in which people choose to self-identify.)

Do you think that God is ok with homosexuality as long they love each other? Why/why not?

What are your friends saying about homosexuality?

What do you think about other expressions of sexuality, like sex outside of marriage, looking at pornography, or making jokes about sex?

Do you do any of those things?

What is your generations beliefs on sex? Do they think it should be saved until marriage or is it something different? Why do you think that is?

What do you think is the reason for such a different view on sexuality in our culture?
