# **Holy Marriage**

- 1 Peter 3:1-7
- 1) How does Peter encourage wives to win over their husbands without words? What does this suggest about the power of actions and attitudes in relationships?
- 2) What does it mean for a wife's beauty to come from her inner self? How can this concept transform our understanding of beauty and value?
- 3) Peter mentions the "unfading beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit." What are some practical ways to cultivate such a spirit in our lives?
- 4) In verse 7, husbands are instructed to "live with your wives in an understanding way." What does this look like in practice, and why is it important?
- 5) How do these verses challenge traditional gender roles? In what ways do they affirm the equality and mutual respect between husbands and wives?
- 6) Peter uses the example of Sarah and Abraham to illustrate his points. What can we learn from their relationship dynamics?
