2 Samuel 24

As a Life Group:

- 1. Pray for one another.
- 2. Pray for those who don't know Christ by name.
- 3. Ask each other: "What has God done in your life this week?"
- 4. Ask each other: "What has God taught you this week?"
- 5. Ask each other: "Have you shared Jesus with anyone this week?"
- 6. How can you serve together as a group?

- In what ways have you contributed to the "success" of Taylor Road at this time, and have you ever felt pride in those areas of service, giving, etc.? How might you turn that pride into humility and boasting in the Lord?
- 2. Has there ever been a time in your past where you saw destructive consequences due to *your* pride? If so, explain.
- 3. Has there ever been a time in your past where you saw destructive consequences due to a *church's* pride? If so, explain.
- 4. How might the gospel have prevented either of the destructive scenarios from questions 3 or 4?
- 5. How does the end of 2 Samuel 24 bring hope for David despite his pride, and how can Taylor Road also enjoy that same hope and restoration with God?
