## Daniel 3:1-30

## As a Life Group:

- 1. Pray for one another.
- 2. Pray for those who don't know Christ by name.
- 3. Ask each other: "What has God done in your life this week?"
- 4. Ask each other: "What has God taught you this week?"
- 5. Ask each other: "Have you shared Jesus with anyone this week?"
- 6. How can you serve together as a group?

- I. Has there ever been a time when you have had to take a bold stand for your faith?
- 2. Has following Jesus ever cost you something? If so, share about that experience. If not, think through relationships, opportunities, worldly advantages, etc. How has standing for truth affected these areas?
- 3. Why do you think the temptation to choose comfort over cost is so strong? Have you been guilty of this?
- 4. Are there areas of your life in which you are tempted to bow to the "god" of this culture?
- 5. What does our choice between compromise or obedience say about our faith? Do you still obey rather than bow even though there is no guarantee that you'll be "rescued?"
- 6. Sometimes God allows us to go through "the fire" like Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. How does God use the fire for our sanctification?
- 7. What is one thing God taught you through this scripture?
