Daniel 3:1-30

As a Life Group:

1. Pray for one another.
 2. Pray for those who don't know Christ by name.
 3. Ask each other: "What has God done in your life this week?"
 4. Ask each other: "What has God taught you this week?"
 5. Ask each other: "Have you shared Jesus with anyone this week?"
 6. How can you serve together as a group?
1. Has there ever been a time when you have had to take a bold stand for your faith?
 2. Has following Jesus ever cost you something? If so, share about that experience. If not, think through relationships, opportunities, worldly advantages, etc. How has standing for truth affected these areas?
 3. Why do you think the temptation to choose comfort over cost is so strong? Have you been guilty of this?
 4. Are there areas of your life in which you are tempted to bow to the "god" of this culture?
 5. What does our choice between compromise or obedience say about our faith? Do you still obey rather than bow even though there is no guarantee that you'll be "rescued?"
 6. Sometimes God allows us to go through "the fire" like Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. How does God use the fire for our sanctification?
 7. What is one thing God taught you through this scripture?
