As a Life Group:

- 3. If your children have grown how have you navigated through times when they haven't been following the Lord? What hope have you found during these times?
- 4. If you are a parent of children who are still at home or if your children are grown, how are you (or, have you) striven to "protect" them? If your children are grown, what are some lessons you learned as you allowed your children to grow, make their own decisions in life, and what has it taught you about trusting the Lord?
- 5. As David watches his family ripped apart by sin, he is completely helpless to save them or fix the brokenness. If you have experienced this, what lessons have you learned about God? About sin? About people?
