Jonah 1:4-17

As a Life Group or Family:

1. Pray for one another.
 2. Pray for those who don't know Christ by name.
 3. Ask each other: "What has God done in your life this week?"
 4. Ask each other: "What has God taught you this week?"
 5. Ask each other: "Have you shared Jesus with anyone this week?"
 6. How can you serve together as a group?
1. Has there ever been a time in your life when you ran from God?
 2. What circumstances in your life did God use to reveal His love and pursuing grace to you?
 3. In Jonah 1, we see Jonah willing to put everyone around him at risk rather than surrender to the Lord's will. How can we be guilty of this and why is it such a temptation?
 4. Jonah's hypocrisy is on full display in chapter one. He knows and confesses all the right things about God but his life is saying something completely different. He's religious but he's running. Has this ever been true in your life? Why do we often times choose hypocrisy over truth?
 5. When you have had seasons of running from God, how have you seen God's pursuit of you?
 6. What did God teach you through this message and scripture?
