1 Peter 4:12-19

- 1) How does Peter encourage believers to respond to suffering and trials in these verses?
- 2) Why do you think Peter emphasizes that suffering is not something strange for Christians to experience?
- 3) According to verse 14, how are believers blessed when they are insulted because of Christ?
- 4) In what ways can suffering for being a Christian lead to spiritual growth and maturity?
- 5) How does verse 16 challenge us to consider our response to suffering and persecution?
- 6) What does it mean to "entrust their souls to a faithful Creator" in the midst of suffering (verse 19)?
- 7) How can we support and encourage one another when facing trials and persecution?



Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you. 13 But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed.
