As a Life Group:

- 1. Pray for one another.
- Pray for those who don't know Christ by name.
- 3. Ask each other: "What has God done in your life this week?"
- 4. Ask each other: "What has God taught you this week?"
- 5. Ask each other: "Have you shared Jesus with anyone this week?"
- 6. How can you serve together as a group?

- 1. As a group, discuss the dangers of David staying home from battle and spending idle time on his roof. How did this leave an open door for sin? What are some examples of this danger in our own lives?
- 2. David allowed his desire to rule over him and lust took over. How real is sexual temptation in our lives and what are some ways you try and safeguard your life against temptation?
- 3. Why is lust so powerful and damaging if it is not controlled and stopped?
- 4. David's cover-up was catastrophic. Why do you think he went to such great lengths to cover for his sin rather than deal with it once the sin happened? How and why do we do the same thing in our lives by choosing **cover-up** over **confession**?
- 5. Sexual sin is devastating. In David's story, Bathsheba was affected, Uriah was affected, Joab was affected, David's future children were affected and the nation of Israel was affected. Why is the fallout of sexual sin more far-reaching than most other sins? How have you seen/experienced the catastrophic fallout of sexual sin?
