October 1 – Pray for the Harvest

Scripture: Matthew 9:37-38

Jesus told His disciples that the harvest is plentiful but the laborers are few. The Fall Festival is a field ready for harvest. Let us pray for God to prepare hearts and send His workers into the field.

Prayer Focus: Pray for God to raise up laborers and prepare hearts for the gospel.

October 2 – Pray for Boldness in Witness

Scripture: Acts 4:29

The early church prayed not for safety, but for boldness. We too must ask God to make us fearless in sharing Christ with our community.

Prayer Focus: Pray that our members will be bold to invite and share Jesus.

October 3 - Pray for Unity in the Church

Scripture: John 17:21

Jesus prayed that His people would be one, so that the world might believe. Unity in our church magnifies the gospel witness.

Prayer Focus: Pray for a spirit of love and unity among our people.

October 4 – Pray for Workers & Volunteers

Scripture: Galatians 6:9

Serving others can be tiring, but God promises a harvest if we do not give up. Volunteers are the hands and feet of Jesus at this event.

Prayer Focus: Pray for strength and encouragement for all volunteers.

October 5 - Pray for Children & Families

Scripture: Mark 10:14

Jesus welcomed children and blessed them. Families are at the heart of our community. May they encounter Christ's love at the festival.

Prayer Focus: Pray for children and parents to be drawn to Christ.

October 6 – Pray for Gospel Conversations

Scripture: Colossians 4:3-4

Paul asked for prayer that doors would open for the gospel. We ask the same. Pray that every conversation is Spirit-led and points to Christ.

Prayer Focus: Pray for clear, Spirit-led gospel conversations.

October 7 – Pray for Our Community

Scripture: Jeremiah 29:7

God calls His people to seek the welfare of the city. We want our community to flourish spiritually through the gospel of Jesus.

Prayer Focus: Pray for God to bless and transform our community.

October 8 – Pray for Protection from the Enemy

Scripture: Ephesians 6:11-12

Spiritual opposition is real, but God's armor is stronger. We must pray against any attack meant to hinder the gospel.

Prayer Focus: Pray for God's protection and victory over the enemy.

October 9 – Pray for Favor with Visitors

Scripture: Proverbs 3:3-4

When God's people walk in love and faithfulness, He grants them favor with others. Pray for visitors to feel welcomed and open to truth.

Prayer Focus: Pray that visitors would feel loved and open to Jesus.

October 10 – Pray for Good Weather

Scripture: James 5:17-18

Just as Elijah prayed for rain and God answered, we too can pray for favorable weather so that nothing hinders participation.

Prayer Focus: Pray for good weather on the day of the festival.

October 11 – Pray for Gospel Seed to Take Root

Scripture: Luke 8:15

The seed of God's Word must fall on good soil. Pray that the gospel is heard, believed, and bears

lasting fruit.

Prayer Focus: Pray for the gospel to take root and grow in hearts.

October 12 - Pray for Our Pastor & Leaders

Scripture: 2 Timothy 4:2

Leaders are called to faithfully proclaim the Word. Pray for wisdom, strength, and endurance for our pastor and leaders.

Prayer Focus: Pray for God's anointing on our pastor and leaders.

October 13 – Pray for Joyful Service

Scripture: Philippians 2:14-15

Serving with joy sets Christians apart as lights in a dark world. May every volunteer radiate Christ's joy.

Prayer Focus: Pray for joyful attitudes among all who serve.

October 14 – Pray for Divine Appointments

Scripture: Acts 8:29-31

God arranges meetings that lead to salvation, just as He sent Philip to the Ethiopian. Pray for Spirit-orchestrated encounters.

Prayer Focus: Pray for divine appointments at the festival.

October 15 – Pray for Revival in Our Church

Scripture: Psalm 85:6

Revival begins in God's house. As we seek Him, may He renew our zeal for Christ and His mission.

Prayer Focus: Pray for revival in our church family.

October 16 – Pray for Broken Lives to be Restored

Scripture: Isaiah 61:1

Jesus came to bind up the brokenhearted and set captives free. Many will come hurting-pray they find

healing in Him.

Prayer Focus: Pray for broken lives to be restored in Christ.

October 17 – Pray for Invitations to Be Accepted

Scripture: Luke 14:23

Jesus spoke of compelling people to come to His banquet. Pray that our invitations are received and

many attend.

Prayer Focus: Pray for people to accept invitations and come.

October 18 – Pray for Safety & Peace

Scripture: Psalm 4:8

God alone makes us dwell in safety. Pray for peace and protection over every aspect of the event.

Prayer Focus: Pray for safety and peace during the festival.

October 19 – Pray for Hearts to be Softened

Scripture: Ezekiel 36:26

God promises to replace hearts of stone with hearts of flesh. Pray for openness to the gospel.

Prayer Focus: Pray for soft hearts ready to believe.

October 20 – Pray for Lasting Relationships

Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 2:8

Paul shared not only the gospel but his very life. Pray for lasting relationships to form between our

church and visitors.

Prayer Focus: Pray for gospel-centered relationships to grow.

October 21 – Pray for a Spirit of Hospitality

Scripture: Romans 12:13

Hospitality is love in action. Pray that our church reflects Christ by joyfully welcoming every guest.

Prayer Focus: Pray for a spirit of hospitality among our members.

October 22 - Pray for Clear Gospel Proclamation

Scripture: Romans 1:16

The gospel is the power of God for salvation. Pray that it is proclaimed with clarity and conviction.

Prayer Focus: Pray for clear gospel proclamation.

October 23 – Pray for God's Presence

Scripture: Exodus 33:15

If God's presence is not with us, all is in vain. Pray that His presence would be felt powerfully at the

festival.

Prayer Focus: Pray for God's presence to be known.

October 24 - Pray for Our Mission Beyond the Festival

Scripture: Matthew 28:19-20

The mission does not end after the festival. Pray for ongoing gospel work and discipleship.

Prayer Focus: Pray for gospel mission beyond the event.

October 25 – Pray with Thanksgiving

Scripture: Philippians 4:6

We must not forget to thank God for what He has done. Gratitude prepares us for more of His blessing.

Prayer Focus: Pray with thanksgiving for God's work.

October 26 – Day of the Festival – Pray for Salvation

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 6:2

Today is the day of salvation! Pray that God would save many souls through the preaching of the

gospel.

Prayer Focus: Pray for salvation to come today.
