BIBLE READING

Read: 2 Samuel 1; 2:1-7; 2 Samuel 3:1; 5; Psalm 23; 2 Samuel 6-7; Psalm 18; 2 Samuel 9; 2 Samuel 11-12

Memorize: Psalms 23:1-3; 51:10-13

PRAYER GUIDE

First of all, then, I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men, for kings and all who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity. This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time (1 Timothy 2:1-6).

Sunday, April 24 — Jesus said that the harvest is plentiful and that we should pray for laborers (Luke 10:2). Pray that many from your church family will become laborers in the spiritual harvest, believers sharing the gospel and leading others to Christ.

Monday, April 25 — When some people hear about the cross of Christ, they see it all as foolishness (1 Corinthians 1:18). Pray that this vain thought will be set aside so people can see the death and resurrection of Jesus as the power of God for salvation.

Tuesday, April 26 — As God's Spirit is moving on hearts in your community, pray that people will respond with a sorrow that produces repentance and leads to salvation (2 Corinthians 7:10).

Wednesday, April 27 — Pray that individuals in your city during the course of this day will confess with their mouths that Jesus is Lord and believe with their hearts that God raised Him from the dead (Romans 10:9).

Thursday, April 28 — Before He ascended to glory, Jesus told His disciples that they would receive power when the Holy Spirit came on them to witness for Him locally and abroad (Acts 1:8). Pray that church members will be filled with God's Spirit and once more commit to spreading the gospel.

Friday, April 29 — During Pentecost, Peter preached under the anointing of the Holy Spirit and in one day saw around three thousand souls added to God's kingdom (Acts 2:41). Pray for God's anointing to rest on pastors and congregations nationwide, and for the lost to be saved in amazing numbers.

Saturday, April 30 — Following Pentecost, the believers in Jerusalem kept feeling a sense of awe as the Lord daily added to their number (Acts 2:43, 47). Pray that once again God will fill churches with large numbers of new converts.
