Jonah 1:1-3

As a Life Group:

- 1. Pray for one another.
- 2. Pray for those who don't know Christ by name.
- 3. Ask each other: "What has God done in your life this week?"
- 4. Ask each other: "What has God taught you this week?"
- 5. Ask each other: "Have you shared Jesus with anyone this week?"
- 6. How can you serve together as a group?

- I. When was the last time you felt like God was calling you to do something difficult?
- 2. Did you obey God's leading in your life or did you find yourself trying to run from obedience?
- 3. Jonah's story is told as satire. Everything in the story happens opposite of what we would expect. We expect the prophet to be obedient and the nations to rebel against God. The opposite, in Jonah, is true. What message does this have for us, as believers, today?
- 4. God's mission is to make his glory known throughout the earth by extending grace to sinners. How are God's grace and His glory connected in your life?
- 5. How have you experienced God's grace pursuing you?
- 6. Jonah tried to stand in God's way of showing grace to his enemies. What is the truth in this for us today?
- 7. What is the biggest thing God taught you through this passage?
