## The Radical Life of Following Jesus (Part 2)

## As A Group...

- 1. Spend time praying for one another.
- 2. Talk about each member's "one" friend or family member who doesn't know Christ. Pray for them by name and encourage and hold one another accountable to share the gospel or offer an invitation to the "one."
- 3. Plan an activity that you can invite unchurched neighbors to so that you can get to know the people around your group.
- 4. Encourage and hold each other accountable in the area of serving. Where is each member serving in the body of Christ and the kingdom?

- 1. Read Mark 10:13-16.
- 2. If you grew up in church, how did your church view and treat children? Were children treated as a "lesser" part of the church or were children celebrated as an active part of the church?
- 3. Sometimes, we are guilty in the church of labeling people as "insignificant" —whether or not we realize we're doing it. What are some examples of ways you have seen people in the church as being guilty of doing this?
- 4. How can Christians in the church be guilty of considering certain members as "unworthy?"
- 5. In treating people as "insignificant" and "unworthy," how are we keeping them from being blessed by Jesus?
- 6. As a group, read I Corinthians 12:12-31 and discuss how this passage relates to Mark 10:13-16.
- 7. As a church, how would you say we do in the area of clearing paths or creating barriers in introducing people to Jesus?
