## Week 10: March 6–12

### BIBLE READING

**Read:** Leviticus 23; Leviticus 26; Numbers 11-12; Numbers 13-14; Numbers 16-17

**Memorize:** Leviticus 26:13 & Deuteronomy 31:7-8

### PRAYER GUIDE

**Sunday, March 6** — Pray today for your pastor, that God will anoint him to articulate the truth of the Word and call the church to walk in God's ways, in the power of His Holy Spirit (1 Kings 17:24).

**Monday, March 7** — Pray that Christians in your community will stop presenting the members of their bodies to sin, but will instead obediently present their bodies to God as those who are alive from the dead, instruments of righteousness to God (Romans 6:13).

**Tuesday, March 8** — John 3:36 tells us that whoever believes in Jesus will have eternal life, but the person who does not obey Him will experience God's wrath. Let's ask today that God will send a great harvest of souls, the largest ingathering of new believers our nation has ever experienced.

**Wednesday, March 9** — Pray that the church will have great wisdom in knowing how to keep God's commands while walking in submission to the authorities He has placed over us (Acts 5:29; Hebrews 13:17).

**Thursday, March 10** — Pray that Christians in your community will be obedient in keeping the Great Commandments. Pray that we will truly love God with all of our hearts, souls, and minds, and love our neighbors as we love ourselves (Matthew 22:37-39).

**Friday, March 11** — Deuteronomy 7:9 tells us that God is faithful to keep His covenant and show lovingkindness to those who love Him and keep His commandments. Pray that Christians in our nation will demonstrate a daily commitment to the lordship of Christ as they walk in God's covenant love.

**Saturday, March 12** — In Psalm 119:127, the psalmist speaks of loving God's commandments more than fine gold. Pray that your congregation will demonstrate this same kind of passion when it comes to loving God and obeying His Word.
