“Soli Deo Gloria”

As A Group...

1. Spend time praying for one another.
2. Talk about each member's "one" friend or family member who doesn't know Christ. Pray for them by name and encourage and hold one another accountable to share the gospel or offer an invitation to the "one."
3. Plan an activity that you can invite unchurched neighbors to so that you can get to know the people around your group.
4. Encourage and hold each other accountable in the area of serving. Where is each member serving in the body of Christ and the kingdom?
1. As a group, read Ephesians 1:1-14.
2. In our series on the 5 Solas, we have unpacked the 5 core doctrinal affirmations of the Protestant Reformation—Scripture Alone, Christ Alone, Grace Alone, Faith Alone, and the Glory of God Alone. As a group, talk about which of these 5 Solas has resonated most deeply with each group member and why.
3. How does Soli Deo Gloria “bind together” all of the other four Solas? In other words, how do each of the first four serve the ultimate purpose of bringing glory to God alone?
4. In Ephesians 1:1-14 we see that from eternity past all the way into eternity future, our salvation is a complete work of God. The Father appointed our salvation, the Son accomplished our salvation, and the Holy Spirit applies our salvation. How does this shape your understanding of your relationship with God?
5. If God saved us for His glory alone how can we live in such a way that every area of our lives bring glory to Him?
6. As you live each day, do you think about the fact that every conversation, every thought, every “minuscule” area of our lives are to bring glory to God?
7. Would you say that the way you spend your time as a family (or individual), spend your money, use your resources, etc. bring glory to God?
