God's Character—Eternality

ADORATION

Adoration

- Psalm 90:1-2
- Pray and give thanks to God for the fact that He is eternal in His being and nature. God has no beginning, no end, and will never change!

Confession

- Psalm 90:7-12
- O Lord, who hast mercy upon all, take away from me my sins, and mercifully kindle in me the fire of thy Holy Spirit.

Take away from me the heart of stone, and give me a heart of flesh, a heart to love and adore Thee, a heart to delight in Thee, to follow and enjoy Thee, for Christ's sake, Amen

God's Protection

Psalm 121

- 1) Read Psalm 121.
- 2) In what ways have you experienced God's protection over your life—physically, spiritually, emotionally, etc.
- 3) Psalm 121 begins by calling the reader to fix their gaze on the Maker of Heaven and Earth rather than on the mountains of trouble. In what ways do you struggle with gazing upon your troubles rather than on God?
- 4) The Psalmist gives God the title, "Protector." What does this say about God's character and His view of His covenant people?
- 5) The Psalmist tells us that our Protector will not let our foot slip. His protective care over us is complete—extending to every area of our lives. How do we oftentimes minimize our view of God's protective care over us? Are we (you) dismissive of the fact that God cares about every minute detail of your life?

- 6) God, our Protector, never sleeps or slumbers. He never takes a day off. What confidence and assurance does that give you and does that change your perspective of how you have viewed God?
- 7) In what ways is God calling you to obedience, faith, and/or trust as a result of this passage?
