“Finishing the Task”

As A Group...

1. Spend time praying for one another.
 2. Talk about each member's "one" friend or family member who doesn't know Christ. Pray for them by name and encourage and hold one another accountable to share the gospel or offer an invitation to the "one."
 3. Plan an activity that you can invite unchurched neighbors to so that you can get to know the people around your group.
 4. Encourage and hold each other accountable in the area of serving. Where is each member serving in the body of Christ and the kingdom?
1. As a group, read 1 Chronicles 28:1-8 & 29:1-13.
 2. This Sunday, Pastor Daniel talked about the fact that, many times, the greatest barrier to God-sized vision is the size of our faith. Talk about this statement. Do you agree or disagree?
 3. How have you seen "small faith" impede someone (or a church) from experiencing God-sized things.
 4. When God puts vision in a person (or church's) heart, it is undeniable and inescapable.
 5. Does God still put vision in the hearts of His people? How does He do this and why do we sometimes miss it?
 6. Why does God put vision into the hearts of His people? For what purposes?
 7. When God's people have a God-sized vision, they are fully and, even, sacrificially committed to it. What does this say about faith and how does a lack of sacrifice and committed reflect on a person (or church's) lack of faith?
 8. When faith and vision are combined there is purpose. How does purpose fuel God's people for God's mission?
 9. As a Life Group, spend some time praying for God to put His vision for our church in our hearts and that we would have the faith to pursue His mission.
