How Great A Salvation

1 Peter 4:1-11

- 1) In verse 1, Peter urges believers to arm themselves with the same attitude as Christ. How can we practically "arm" ourselves with this attitude in our daily lives?
- 2) Verse 2 talks about living for the will of God rather than human desires. What are some common human desires that can distract us from God's will, and how can we overcome them?
- 3) Peter mentions that our past life was characterized by different behaviors (verse 3). How has your life changed since you began following Christ, and what areas are you still working on?
- 4) According to verse 7, what is the purpose of prayer, and how can we cultivate a consistent prayer life that reflects this purpose?
- 5) Verse 8 speaks about the importance of love. How can we show genuine love for one another, and why is it so significant in our witness to the world?
- 6) Peter encourages believers to use their gifts to serve others (verse 10). What are some



practical ways we can identify and utilize our spiritual gifts within the church and the community?

- 7) In verse 11, Peter emphasizes the importance of doing everything for the glory of God. How can we glorify God in our everyday actions and decisions?

- 8) How does the passage in 1 Peter 4:1-11 challenge us to live differently from the culture around us, and what steps can we take to align our lives more closely with God's will?
