### Parson to Person

Spring is springing out all around us! Baseball, post-season basketball, turkey hunting, yard work, tulips, redbud trees, dog wood trees, Day-Light Savings, warm weather, all mixed in with a random chance of snow. In all of the excitement, I want us to get ready for Easter, which is at the very first part of April.

### Holy Week is April 2-9.

\*Unity Worship: That Friday before Palm Sunday, we will have a community worship service at the Tanglefoot Pavilion. That's on the 31st.

\*Sunday, April 2, I will preach on "Christ in the Passover," which explains the Lord's Supper.

\*Easter Lunches: Monday-Thursday at noon in our Fellowship Hall we will serve a free lunch with someone to lead us in music and then a Word. You will be out by 12:45pm.

\*Prayer Vigil: Beginning Thursday at 6:00pm till Friday at 6:00pm. We invite you to join us in the Sanctuary to pray.

\*Good Friday Lord's Supper: At noon on Good Friday, we will have a powerful (albeit short) Lord's Supper service in the Sanctuary.

### \*Easter Sunday School.

This Easter we are trying to beat our last high attendance from back in November. We had 510

people. Usually on Easter we will have 700+ in worship. Yet, most of the 700 don't make it to Sunday School. I understand that people usually have family Easter traditions. I am going to ask you to move those back an hour for Sunday School. I know that some will be coming in from out of town and don't have a Sunday School to attend. We are making plans for them as well. We are calling this "Plus 1." Our goal is to get at least 511 people in Sunday School for that day. We really could/ should have 700 in Sunday School.

This is why getting people to Sunday School on Easter is so important. People will come to worship service on that day, but they aren't necessarily going to be connected until they get into a group. Without that connection, they won't have a group of people to love them and support them when times get tough. They won't have a group of people to help them navigate through the tough issues of life-raising kids, having a healthy marriage, love, forgiveness, grief, an knowing God. It is through Sunday School where kids get their foundational understanding of God and salvation. Sunday School is made for families. Parents need to bring their kids to Sunday School and parents need support on their own.

So, I am going to ask you to bring one. On a recent wedding invitation, I was asked who is my "Plus 1?" I am asking you to bring your "Plus 1." And if each of us brings our "Plus 1," we will not only meet 511, but surpass that number.

Remember, 511 is not the goal. The goal is to help people. I believe having a loving support group is a vital help to people and families.
