Let's begin 2021 with 21 days of transformative prayer! Transforming the world, our nation, and our community for Jesus Christ first begins with Holy Spirit wrought transformation in each of us personally. With the Scriptures as your framework, this 21-Day Prayer Guide takes you through the transformative prayers: ***Search Me. Break Me. and Make Me.***

As you read the daily verse, meditate on these reflective questions in your prayer time with the Lord: ***What am I learning? • What am I thankful for? • What do I regret? • What do I need to repent from? • Where do I need the help of the Holy Spirit? • Who else do I need to pray for today? • What do I need to do today?*** Over the next 21 days, may the Lord transform us together!

DECEMBER 27 --- JANUARY 2

- 1 Psalm 139:23 – Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts!
- 2 Matthew 6:9-10 – Our Father who is in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
- 3 Psalm 86:11 – Teach me your way, O LORD, that I may walk in your truth; unite my heart to fear your name.
- 4 Psalm 26:2 – Prove me, O LORD, and try me; test my heart and my mind.
- 5 Isaiah 61:1 – The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives and freedom to prisoners.
- 6 Isaiah 6:8 – And I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?” Then I said, “Here I am! Send me.”
- 7 Psalm 51:1 – Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions.

JANUARY 3 --- JANUARY 9

- 8 Jeremiah 8:18, 21 – My grief is beyond healing; my heart is broken. I hurt with the hurt of my people. I mourn and am overcome with grief.
- 9 Psalm 1:1-2 – How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, nor stand in the path of sinners, nor sit in the seat of scoffers! But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night.

10 James 4:6-8 – But He gives a greater grace. Therefore it says, “God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble.” Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

11 Matthew 9:36-38 – Seeing the people, He felt compassion for them, because they were distressed and dispirited like sheep without a shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, “The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Therefore, beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest.”

12 James 5:16 – Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.

13 Psalm 51:16-17 – For You do not delight in sacrifice, otherwise I would give it; You are not pleased with burnt offering. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and a contrite heart, O God, You will not despise.

14 2 Corinthians 1:3-4 – Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our affliction so that we will be able to comfort those who are in any affliction with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.

JANUARY 10 --- JANUARY 16

15 Philippians 3:12-14 – Not that I have already obtained it or have already become perfect, but I press on so that I may lay hold of that for which also I was laid hold of by Christ Jesus. Brethren, I do not regard myself as having laid hold of it yet; but one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and reaching forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

16 Psalm 139:24 – And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!

17 John 17:18-21 – As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world. For their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they themselves also may be sanctified in truth. I do not ask on behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word; that they may all be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me.

18 Psalm 19:14 – Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my rock and my Redeemer.

19 Proverbs 30:7-9 – Two things I ask of you; deny them not to me before I die: Remove far from me falsehood and lying; give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with the food that is needful for me, lest I be full and deny you and say, “Who is the Lord?” or lest I be poor and steal and profane the name of my God.

20 Psalm 43:3 – Send out your light and your truth; let them lead me; let them bring me to your holy hill and to your dwelling!

21 Acts 1:8 – “but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth.”
