## Small Groups Discussion Questions

### **Week 1: Trading Places**

**Scripture: John 8:1-11**

#### **1. Our Instinct for Fairness**

**Why do we care so much about fairness?**

**When was a time you felt you were treated unfairly?**

#### **2. Trying to Be “Good Enough” for God**

**In what ways do people try to make a “fair trade” with God—  
as if good behavior or religious activity could earn His approval?**

**Why do we tend to think this way?**

#### **3. Stones in Our Hands**

**In John 8, the crowd was ready to stone the woman.**

**Why do you think it’s easier to focus on someone else’s sin than our own?**

**If you had been in that crowd, what might Jesus have said to you?**

#### **4. Grace Before Truth**

**Jesus said, “Neither do I condemn you,” and then, “Go and sin no more.”**

**Why is that order important?**

**What happens if we reverse it?**

#### **5. The Unfair Trade of the Gospel**

- Read Romans 8:1 and 2 Corinthians 5:21.**

**According to these verses, what do we deserve because of sin?**

**What does Jesus give us instead?**

#### **6. Living in the Unfair Grace of God**

**How would your attitude change this week if you truly believed:**

**“There is now no condemnation for me in Christ”?**

**Who in your life might need to experience that same grace through you?**
