## Small Groups Discussion Questions

### **Week 4: “Where Two or Three Gathered”**

**Scripture: Matthew 18:20**

**Big Idea: This verse isn't about small group prayer — it's Jesus assuring His presence in the hard, often uncomfortable work of church discipline and reconciliation.**

**1. Church hurt is real.**

How difficult is it for you to talk with someone who has offended or hurt you? Is it easier or harder when that person is a fellow believer? Why?

**2. Nobody looks forward to difficult conversations.**

If you've ever had to address a hard issue with someone, what made you decide it was worth it?

**3. Spiritual welfare requires spiritual courage.**

Read **Ephesians 4:15** and **Galatians 6:1**.

What responsibility do we have toward one another in the body of Christ? What are the risks of stepping into someone's life like this? What are the possible rewards?

**4. Humility comes before honesty.**

When having a “come to Jesus” conversation, how can you make sure your goal is to win a brother or sister—not just win an argument?

**5. Jesus promises to be present in these moments of accountability and restoration (Matthew 18:20).**

Why is that promise important?

How does knowing Jesus is present change the way we approach hard conversations?
