



Philippians 4:4

1:18 What does it matter? Only that in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is proclaimed, and in this I rejoice. Yes, and I will continue to rejoice.

2:17-18 But even if I am poured out as a drink offering on the sacrificial service of your faith, I am glad and *rejoice* with all of you. <sup>18</sup> In the same way you should also be glad and *rejoice* with me.

2:28 For this reason, I am very eager to send him so that you may rejoice again when you see him and I may be less anxious.

3:1 In addition, my brothers and sisters, rejoice in the Lord. To write to you again about this is no trouble for me and is a safeguard for you.

4:4 Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!

4:10 I rejoiced in the Lord greatly because once again you renewed your care for me. You were, in fact, concerned about me but lacked the opportunity to show it.
