Sermon Title: “Are You Coming to the Wedding?””

Text: Revelation 19:6-9

Date: Sunday, Sunday, October 19, 2025

Revelation 19:6-9, “Hallelujah! For our Lord God Almighty reigns. Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready. Fine linen, bright and clean, was given her to wear. Then the angel said to me, “Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb!” And he added, “These are the true words of God.”

Truth for Today

- God’s **promises** don’t have an **expiration** date.
- What cost Jesus **everything** is offered to you for **nothing**.
- Saying, “**maybe later**” to God is the same as saying “**no**.”

Bottom Line:

An invitation without a **reservation** misses the **celebration**.

1. The Invitation Is For Every **Generation**.

- What began as a promise to one **man** became an invitation for the whole **world**.
- The Church is God’s long-game **answer** to a world of short **attention** spans.
- Humanity’s story ends with a **wedding**, not a **war**.

II. The Invitation Is Free, But It Wasn't Cheap.

- The host provides the **garments** to ensure no one is **excluded** because of status.
- The Christian life is about **preparation**, not **perfection**.
- Our seats are saved not because of our **worth**, but because of His **work**.

III. The Invitation Requires a Response.

- Jesus' invitation is **universal**, but it's not **automatic**.
- Indifference + hesitation = **rejection**
- Salvation is an open **invitation**, but it demands a personal **decision**.



Application:

- Respond while the door is still **open**. Today's hesitation can become tomorrow's **regret**.
- Live ready, not **distracted**. Prepare your heart daily as if the **wedding** were tomorrow.
- Invite others to the **celebration**. Don't just save your seat. Help others find **theirs**.

Reflection Questions:

1. Where in your life have you allowed indifference or hesitation to silence your response to God's invitation?
2. How can you live in greater readiness for Christ's return instead of being caught up in temporary pursuits?
3. Who in your life still needs to hear that the invitation to the wedding feast includes them?

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
