Everyone wants to live a long and healthy life. But few are willing to work hard at what it takes to achieve health. And... whose definition of healthy are we working with?! Churches and Christians need to make God's definition of health their focus. This week we go beyond unity and into a necessary reality of God's definition of spiritual body health. If we want to take spiritual ground, we each have a part to play!

Cholesterol...a test can reveal unhealth. But what is healthy? → What creates a healthy church? → Eph. 4:7-16

Where have we been? What is the book of Ephesians all about?

Before we can understand what we can do for God...we must understand what God has done for us.

The church is born OUT OF what God has done for people. We can't do church without God.

3 weeks ago: Humility, gentleness, patience, & forbearance = NECESSARY ATTRIBUTES for UNITED community life. **This week**: We are talking about healthy church...

4.7-11 7 However, he has given each one of us a special gift through the generosity of Christ. 8 That is why the Scriptures say, "When he ascended to the heights, he led a crowd of captives and gave gifts to his people." 9 Notice that it says "he ascended." This clearly means that Christ also descended to our lowly world. 10 And the same one who descended is the one who ascended higher than all the heavens, so that he might fill the entire universe with himself. 11 Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers.

7-11:God gifts the church with people.→Scripture: All gifts come from our generous God!

- In fact, Jesus left Heaven to come to Earth to die on a cross to make sure we have His gifts (8-9).
 - Salvation (Rom. 6:23 See full verses below)
 - Holy Spirit (Lk. 11:13)
 - Station in life (marriage/singleness 1 Cor. 7:7)
 - ministry (Eph. 3:7-8)
 - spiritual gifts (1 Cor. 12:28)

• PEOPLE (Eph. 4:8 & 11) - God uses people to lead His church!→4 fold / 5 fold...God fold?!

• Thank God for His gifts.→I am grateful for the spiritual leaders God has used in my life.→Jeremy Kinlock

- Voluntarily allow God's leaders to play the role He intends for them in your life.
- And what is a church leader's unique responsibility so you can play your unique responsibility? Lets read...

12-15 Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ. 13 This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ. 14 Then we will no longer be immature like children. We won't be tossed and blown about by every wind of new teaching. We will not be influenced when people try to trick us with lies so clever they sound like the truth. 15 Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church.

12-15:God assigns people responsibility.→Scripture: churches get healthy when people fulfill their responsibilities.

- Christian leaders serve by EQUIPPING God people to do his work & build up the church (health):
 - Unity in faith & Knowledge of Jesus
 - that we will be mature measuring UP to the full and complete standard of Christ
 - No longer immature children who are easily deceived like a boat tossed around in the waves
 - We will speak the Truth in love
 - Growing more and more LIKE CHRIST (the head of the church)
 - How do Christian leaders do this?→Preaching/teaching, Groups, Serving, Social Media→Relationships
 - Christian leaders are like coaches. They aren't actually on the playing field of your life! SUPPORT
- Steve Wynn Story→Who has the greater mission...a hotel or a church?
- Christians serve by DOING God's work/the work of ministry: ANYTHING that connects people to God.
 - Your job could connect people to God.
 - Your marriage could connect people to God.
 - Your hobbies could connect people to God.
 - The Dream Team connects people to God→We are setting the Table for Jesus & whoever shows.
- And what happens when Christian leaders serve by equipping and the church serves by doing?

16 He makes the whole body fit together perfectly. As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is healthy and growing and full of love.

14-16:God will fits us together AS we put forth the effort.→Scripture: the result is growth, health & love.

- Each of us has to do our part.→Things we all do:
 - We all show up.→Try to be consistent in your attendance...but also...in SHOWING UP TO LIFE.
 - We all give financially.→Try to Give something...even if you cant give what you'd like to give.
 - We all serve with our time/talent.→Join a Dream Team...and help us set the table every Sunday.→168 hours
