"If you love me, you will shave your beard."→Our actions must align with our beliefs!→1 John 2:3-14

→How do we really know we are Christian? A genuine and authentic faith begins with a historical and incarnate Christ. He really showed up and we must really show up to follow him in our lives if we want to claim the Truth lives in us, too. And yet, many, in today's world, believe that to be their authentic and true self, they must embrace their sinful nature and follow their temptations. But John challenges that lie. We cannot follow Jesus without obeying his commandments.

→**Text Background**: John writes to rebut deceptive teaching advocating for compromise. His churches were influenced by <u>Gnostics</u> who believed "sin" was ignorance of spirit's superiority over matter, thus anything done in the body didn't matter; <u>Cerinthians</u>, a specific form of Gnosticism; and the <u>Docetists</u> who believed Jesus was only a divine mirage. John challenges our faith through the right view of Jesus (**doctrine**) & keeping His commands/love (**praxis**).

1 John **2:3-14**: 3 And we can be sure that we know him if we obey his commandments. 4 If someone claims, "I know God," but doesn't obey God's commandments, that person is a liar and is not living in the truth. 5 But those who obey God's word truly show how completely they love him. That is how we know we are living in him. 6 Those who say they live in God should live their lives as Jesus did.

7 Dear friends, I am not writing a new commandment for you; rather it is an old one you have had from the very beginning. This old commandment—to love one another—is the same message you heard before. 8 Yet it is also new. Jesus lived the truth of this commandment, and you also are living it. For the darkness is disappearing, and the true light is already shining.

9 If anyone claims, "I am living in the light," but hates a fellow believer, that person is still living in darkness. 10 Anyone who loves a fellow believer is living in the light and does not cause others to stumble. 11 But anyone who hates a fellow believer is still living and walking in darkness. Such a person does not know the way to go, having been blinded by the darkness.

Obediance proves we love God.→Isn't this legalism?→TRUSTING God's wisdom will help us love God more.

- Legalism: Dependance on RULES over RELATIONSHIP for salvation.→"I should pray more" vs. "I love to pray"
- Three types of Law in Scripture: A mature follower of Jesus loves God THROUGH their obedience to the Law.
 - Moral [ordinances]: 10 Commandments, justice, sexual practices.→Based on God's nature.
 - Ceremonial [statutes]: Customs, rituals, festivals → Based on God's desire to separate Israel (holiness).
 - Civil: Given for culture & place of Israelites.→Based on cultural responsibilities of moral law, justice.
 - Jesus words: in Mt. 7:24→ "Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise..."→Live like Jesus!

• Love requires training, not trying! \rightarrow Runner \rightarrow Mt. 22:37-40 \rightarrow "Love God with all our heart, soul, & mind...

• VISION: A healthy Mesa Church is a church that is training to Love God through our obedience. → Prayer → TRANSITION: If we love God & obey His commandments, we will be able to love people well.

Loving each other proves we love God.→We can't love each other well...If we don't love God with all of our hearts.

- This isn't a new commandment. It goes all the way to the beginning…but now we have a new way of understanding it through Jesus. He loved people perfectly (7-8).→We are called to LOVE people like Jesus loves people.→Rom. 5:8
- Only love can drive out darkness.→MLK. Jr. Quote→Rick Warren Quote
- Elizabeth Leland tells the story of Joe Hill (15, developmentally disabled / black in 1935)→Babe / Henry Hill→Marvin / Mattie Letherman (45 years)→Marguerite/Dr. Leary Reid→"We'll take care of you…"
- VISION: A healthy Mesa Church is a church that loves people .→Prayer

→TRANSITION: Loving God requires training...and loving each other requires God's love...and the final proof?

Going the distance proves we love God.→People of every maturity level need encouragement!
