Acts 1:8 (NIV) “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

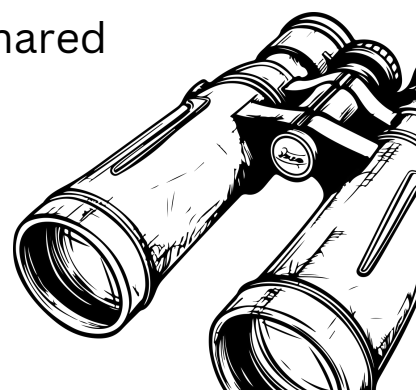
Question of the Day: What if being “sent” isn’t a privilege for the few, but the responsibility of every believer?

Truth for Today

- God invites us to join Him in His mission to redeem, restore, and rebuild what sin has destroyed.
- God sent His Spirit not only to comfort us, but to commission us.
- God sends ordinary people into everyday places with extraordinary hope.

Bottom Line: Being sent is not a special calling; it’s the shared calling of every Christian.

1: God always works through imperfect people to accomplish His perfect plan. (2 Corinthians 5:18-20)



A witness testifies to two things: what they have seen and what they have heard.

Being a witness is not about having a flawless story, but about pointing to a faithful Savior.

The gospel is most believable when it's carried by people who know they need it.

Application: Choose one person this week and be intentional about sharing what you've seen God do and what you've heard Him say in your life.

2: God provides supernatural power to accomplish a supernatural task.
(John 14:16-18, 20)

- God never asks us to do something He doesn't empower us to do.
- God's presence is the difference between trying harder and watching God do what we can't do.
- God's Spirit bridges the gap between our calling and our capabilities.

Application: Identify one situation this week where you feel inadequate, and intentionally invite the Holy Spirit to help you rather than relying on yourself.

3: God accomplishes His mission through ordinary faithfulness in everyday places.
(Matthew 28:18-20)

- The Great Commission turns ordinary life into a sacred opportunity.
- God multiplies everyday obedience for eternal impact.
- We don't wait to be sent. We live sent right where we are.

Application: Pay attention this week to the people and moments God may already be at work around you, and join Him in what He's doing.
