Joshua 1:9 – "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

## **Truth for Today:**

- Our **earthly** battles are no match for the King of **heaven**.
- Knowing God's promises fuels the <u>courage</u> to act and the <u>confidence</u> to ask.
- Hope lives in <u>light</u> of His <u>victory</u>.

#### **Bottom Line:**

When **we've** done all **we** can do, **God** will do what only **He** can do.

I. When **God** fights for you, no **enemy** can stand against you. (Joshua 10:5-11)

The battle was already won before a sword was even swung.

God's <u>Sovereignty</u> > Your <u>Strategy</u>.

Romans 8:31, "If God is for us, who can be against us?"

II. God's promises inspire big moves and bold prayers. (Joshua 10:9, 12)

## **God's Promises: Participation > Passivity**

"Pray as though everything depended on God. Work as though everything depended on you."

- St. Augustine

Matthew 21:22, 'If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer.'"

Faith doesn't <u>measure</u> the <u>size</u> of the mountain; it <u>trusts</u> in the God who can **move** it.

III. The <u>risen</u> Son guarantees our <u>victory</u>. (Joshua 10:13-15)

The same God who made the sun stand still made His Son stand up.

**John 1:4-5,** "In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it."

**Revelation 22:5,** "There will be no more night. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give them light. And they will reign for ever and ever."
