Congregational Reading:

John 1:49, "Then Nathanael declared, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God; you are the king of Israel." He then added, "Very truly I tell you, you will see 'heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending on' the Son of Man."

Question of the Day: What would change in your life if you gave God your yes today?

Bottom Line: Clarity follows commitment.

I. He Finds Us First.

- Love always initiates. (1:43)
- Commitment precedes comprehension. (1:43)
- Found people find people. (1:44-45)

Application: Where in your life is Jesus inviting you to follow before you fully understand?

II. He Sees Us Before We See Him.

- Cynicism is the armor of wounded hope. (1:46)
- He sees us when we feel unseen. (1:47-48)
- Confession turns our questions into confidence. (1:49)

Application: What questions, doubts, or disappointments might be keeping you guarded from saying yes?

III. He Has a Greater **Plan** Than We Can **Imagine**.

- All we've **seen** is not all there **is**. (1:50)
- Being **found** changes your **future**. (1:50)
- He turns distance into access. (1:51)

Application: Where do you still feel distance between you and God?
