

Enough is Enough | More Than Enough Matthew 6:21

What does God want for us?→He wants OUR hearts to reflect HIS GENEROUS HEART! Where do we stand in comparison to the rest of the world? Giving FUELS the mission of the church! → Leading people into a growing relationship with Jesus.

→WHAT IS REALLY AT STAKE?

Matthew 6:21: "Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be."

We can't be disciples of Jesus, if we won't let him teach us about money. → Jesus talks more about money than Heaven & Hell COMBINED. → Jesus talks about \$\$\$ more than anything else except Kingdom of God. → 500 verses = prayer, faith each < 2k verses on money/possessions→11/39 parables = \$\$\$→1/7 verses in Luke = \$\$\$→OUR HEARTS

- Tithe = FIRST tenth.
- The tithe is a form of training wheels to learn how generosity works!
 - Genesis 4: Genesis 14:19-20: Genesis 28:20-22: Proverbs 3:9-10: Malachi 3:10:
 - Matthew 23:23: Mark 12:41-44: Luke 6:38: Acts 2:44-45: Acts 4:32-35: 1 Timothy 6:10:
- Our response to teaching on finances is a barometer reading of the condition of our heart.

Do I trust God enough to tithe?→How do we do it?→THE PIPES!

- Can God do more with the 90 than we can with the 100?→That is trust!
 - 1. **Taxes = 28%**
 - 2. Giving = Tithe: 10% / Offerings: 2%
 - 3. Savings = 10% 4. Lifestyle = 50%

 - 5. **PROBLEM** = DEBT!→We begin to rob ourselves, God...& God forbid, the Government!
- We will always have an excuse!

What is my next step?→Tithing is not something you have to pray about!→CHART: Take your place!

- Tara and I have practiced this in our our marriage. → Finances is the LAST thing we will ever argue about.
- Missions / Missionaries supported → AMOUNT TOTAL!
- Plan. Vision. Dream. → We are going to talk about the plan. But what would it look like to have a vision to give more?
 - 1. TITHE! 90 Day Tithe Challenge
 - 2. Financial Peace Seminar in January→Sign up in the lobby.
 - 3. Fill out a COMMITMENT CARD.

→When Jesus has our hearts, enough will be enough. →And ENOUGH changes the world!

TALK ABOUT IT - Questions to GROW through with family, friends, & myself.

- 1. What does it mean for me to choose "enough" in my life?
- 2. How does the Biblical pattern of the first fruits or the tithe develop and Scripture? What does the NT pattern reflect?
- 3. Reflect on Jesus' statement, "Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be." Are my financial priorities aligned with a "heart after God?"
- 4. How would the financial impact (e.g., paying off the mortgage, supporting missionaries, serving the community) influence our local community and beyond if every believer at Mesa embraced a lifestyle of generosity?
- 5. **PRAYER**: "Father, change our hearts so that our hearts will reflect you mission, your vision, and your values.

TEACHING NUGGETS:

Israelite Practice of "Tithing"

- 1st Tithe = Bring the priest's due. Then bring the basic tithe = 10%→Leviticus 27:30
- 2nd Tithe (another 10%) = to Jerusalem/needs--it could be spent in Jerusalem on the three annual pilgrimages, somewhat of a pilgrimage budget. No go…send the money!→Deuteronomy 14:22-23
- Every other year a 3rd tithe = , which went to the poor. So the basic tithing was probably over 22% any given year, possibly 27%→Deuteronomy 14:28-29
- DOES NOT INCLUDE: the offerings, the animals that were to be brought to the three festivals. → Various offerings and festival regulations are detailed in the books of **Leviticus**, **Numbers**, and **Deuteronomy**.
- DOES NOT INCLUDE sin/trespass offerings, which could be high, based on the sin. → Various sin and trespass offerings are detailed in the books of **Leviticus** and **Numbers**.
- DOES NOT INCLUDE Sabbath year, 1/7th of their income over a 7 year period would be given up. → Exodus 23:10-11
- DOES NOT INCLUDE Jubilee: 1/49th of it for Jubilee. → Leviticus 25:8-17
- DOES NOT INCLUDE: corners of their fields for the poor to glean; gifts to charity; & care for the widow, orphan, poor & the stranger. → Leviticus 19:9-10, Deuteronomy 15:7-11, Exodus 22:22-24
- DOES NOT INCLUDE: free will thank offering--more animals/gifts. So then, if someone today wants to live under the Law of Israel in this respect. → Leviticus 7:11-18

EASILY exceeded 40% a year!

Eat the tithe of your grain, new wine and olive oil, and the firstborn of your herds and flocks in the presence of the Lord your God at the place he will choose as a dwelling for his Name, so that you may learn to revere the Lord your God always."
- Deuteronomy 15:10: "Give generously to the poor, not grudgingly, for the Lord your God will bless you in everything you do."
- 1 Chronicles 29:14: "But who am I, and who are my people, that we could give anything to you? Everything we have has come from you, and we give you only what you first gave us!"
- 2 Chronicles 31:4-5: "Moreover, he commanded the people who lived in Jerusalem to give the portion due to the priests and the Levites, that they might give themselves to the Law of the Lord. As soon as the command was spread abroad, the people of Israel gave in abundance the firstfruits of grain, wine, oil, honey, and of all the produce of the field. And they brought in abundantly the tithe of everything."
- Nehemiah 10:35-37: "We obligate ourselves to bring the firstfruits of our ground and the firstfruits of all fruit of every tree, year by year, to the house of the Lord; also to bring to the house of our God, to the priests who minister in the house of our God, the firstborn of our sons and of our cattle, as it is written in the Law, and the firstborn of our herds and of our flocks; and to bring the first of our dough, and our contributions, the fruit of every tree, the wine and the oil, to the priests, to the chambers of the house of our God; and to bring to the Levites the tithes from our ground, for it is the Levites who collect the tithes in all our towns where we labor."
- **Proverbs 3:9-10:** "Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. Then he will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with good wine."

- **2 Corinthians 9:10**: "For God is the one who provides seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, he will provide and increase your resources and then produce a great harvest of generosity in you."

I know you have always been concerned for me, but you didn't have the chance to help me. 11 Not that I was ever in need, for I have learned how to be content with whatever I have. 12 I know how to live on almost nothing or with everything. I have learned the secret of living in every situation, whether it is with a full stomach or empty, with plenty or little. 13 For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength."
