Pitfall Prayers | PRAY FIRST Hebrews 10:19-22 & Luke 9:23

"Why isn't God answering my prayers?" → Pitfall prayers are designed to FAIL!

Today, we dive into "pitfall prayers" – prayers that are designed get stuck. But even when our prayers are failing, they are good for something. They reveal our need for Jesus, who connects us to God and transforms our prayer approach. Discover how Jesus uses unanswered prayers to transform our hearts and lives.

Examples:

Lord, I need this RIGHT NOW.

Father, can you just give me a ferrari.

Lord, i will follow you IF you help me pass the test.

Lord you've forgiven me...but i cant forgive my neighbor. He is too loud.

Jesus, YOU ARE AWESOME...and so am i might i add.

Jesus...im not as bad as those other people....you know those other people who arent as good as me.

Lord...i didn't even know why i call you that...because...well, you aren't. I do what i want!

God...you know i cant open up to these people...if they only knew what was really inside of me!

God, i have zero problem with the sin in my life...and you shouldn't have any problem answering my prayers.

Pitfall prayers are designed to get STUCK!→DANGER: JUDGING OTHERS/CONDEMN MYSELF!→2 Cor. 5:17

- 1. **Impatient Prayer: Ecclesiastes 3:1** (NLT): "For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven."
- 2. **Selfish Prayer: James 4:3** (NLT): "And even when you ask, you don't get it because your motives are all wrong—you want only what will give you pleasure."
- 3. **Divided Prayer: James 1:6-7** (NLT): "But when you ask him, be sure that your faith is in God alone. Do not waver, for a person with divided loyalty is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is blown and tossed by the wind. Such people should not expect to receive anything from the Lord."
- 4. **Bitter Prayer: Mark 11:25** (NLT): "But when you are praying, first forgive anyone you are holding a grudge against, so that your Father in heaven will forgive your sins, too."
- 5. Attention Seeking Prayer: Matthew 6:5-6 (NLT): "When you pray, don't be like the hypocrites who love to pray publicly on street corners and in the synagogues where everyone can see them. I tell you the truth, that is all the reward they will ever get."
- 6. **Prideful Prayer: Luke 18:9-14** (NLT): "But the Pharisee stood by himself and prayed this prayer: 'I thank you, God, that I am not like other people—cheaters, sinners, adulterers. I'm certainly not like that tax collector!'"
- 7. Lawless Prayer: Proverbs 28:9 (NLT): "God detests the prayers of a person who ignores the law."
- 8. **Insincere Prayer: James 5:16** (NLT): "Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results."
- 9. **Deceitful Prayer: Psalm 66:18** (NLT): "If I had not confessed the sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened."
- Pitfall prayers are prayers prayed by PEOPLE. They reveals something about us, don't they? Pitfall prayers DON'T WORK because they reveal something...?

Pitfall prayers reveal we need Jesus.→Even unanswered prayers are good for something!

Jesus IS our pathway to the Father. → No bridge. → Bridge with verse (Hebrews 10:19-22).

Jesus IS the pathway of our we were designed to pray. → Bridge with verse (Luke 9:23). Then he said to the crowd,
 "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross daily, and follow me.
 Jesus connects us to God...AND connects us to the way we were designed to pray.

Jesus uses unanswered prayers to change the way we pray. → Unanswered prayers are an invitation.

- God uses prayer to change...US & the way were designed top pray.
 - 1.Deceitful Prayer→Confessional prayer admits sin.
 - 2.Insincere Prayer → Sincere prayer prayer reflects a genuine pursuit of Christ-likeness.
 - 3.Lawless Prayer→Submitted prayers recognize God as sovereign and His boundaries as gifts.
 - 4. Prideful Prayer → Humble prayer does not compare my sins to others' sin.
 - 5.Attention Seeking Prayer -> Secret prayer finds acceptance/approval in God alone.
 - 6.Bitter Prayer→Grace packed prayers.→Grace packed prayers are prayed by forgiven people.
 - 7.Divided Prayer→Faith filled prayers follow Jesus no matter the outcome.
 - 8.Selfish Prayer→Selfless, compassionate, & generous prayers are directed to the benefit of others.
 - 9.Impatient Prayers → Persistent prayers. → NEXT WEEK: Unanswered prayers to unprayed for answers.
