

Speak Only Truth | Written in Stone Exodus 20:1-2, 16, Proverbs 6:16-19, John 8:44, James 3:5-6, Proverbs 18:21

What is the 9th commandment and WHY does it matter?

God has set us free so we can live free. That means loving God with all of our hearts, minds, and souls. isn't that what Jesus said? That way we can love others as God created us to love them... "as ourselves." We dive deeper into the Ten Commandments and discover loving others as ourselves mean we speak ONLY truth about others. The power of life and death is in the tongue, and we want to use ours to cultivate life! Jesus provides the long term solution. Just as the 10 Commandments didn't save the Israelites, they don't save us. But they do provide a framework to build a community of FREE people. Free for what? To follow, serve, & worship God!

Exodus 20:1-2, 16: Then God gave the people all these instructions: 2 "I am the Lord your God, who rescued you from the land of Egypt, the place of your slavery. (Relational-personal God who has rescuED us from slavery to FREEDOM) 16 "You must not testify falsely against your neighbor.

Proverbs 6:16-19: "There are six things the Lord hates—no, seven things he detests: haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that kill the innocent, a heart that plots evil, feet that race to do wrong, a false witness who pours out lies, **a person who sows discord in a family."**

We must not testify falsely against our neighbor. → Vertical → Horizontal → This is WRONG.

- Is it ever ok to lie?→Harmful: Joseph→Humorous: "no calories" →Helpful: To save lives: Rahab/Hebrew midwives)→Marriages
- In ancient times...eye witness testimony was the most important kind of evidence.
 - JUST MERCY Walter McMillian, who is Black, was convicted and sentenced to death for the murder of a young white woman who worked as a clerk in a dry cleaning store in Monroeville, Alabama. Mr. McMillian was held on death row prior to being convicted and sentenced to death. His trial lasted only a day and a half. Three witnesses testified against Mr. McMillian and the jury ignored multiple alibi witnesses, who were Black, who testified that he was at a church fish fry at the time of the crime. The trial judge overrode the jury's sentencing verdict for life and sentenced Mr. McMillian to death. https://eji.org/cases/walter-mcmillian/
 - "For every 9 people executed in this country, one person on death row has been exonerated." "Just Mercy"
 - Studies est. that 4-6% of people who are incarcerated are innocent. = 120k innocent people in prison
 - 27 / 44 = Innocent Project, 375 people exonerated by DNA evidence→Perjury/false statements under oath
- Who is our neighbor? -> Jesus answered that question...in the Good Samaritan parable. Luke 22
- · How do we testify falsely against our neighbor?
 - Gossip:1 Timothy 5:13 → Lying → Libel (written) / slander (spoken) → Misrepresentation → Exaggeration → embellishment → Selective omission → Withholding the truth → Flattery: Psalm 12:2 → Deception:1 John 3:7 → Slander: Lev. 19:16 → False teaching:2 Peter 2:1
- Why does this matter? → Jewish Rabbi Tale Pic
- Where does lying coming from?→"Did God really say that?"
 - John 8:44: For you are the children of your father the devil, and you love to do the evil things he does. He was a murderer from the beginning. He has always hated the truth because there is no truth in him. When he lies, it is consistent with his character; for he is a liar and the father of lies."
 - Diabolos (διάβολος) = derived from Greek verb "diaballo," which means "to slander" or "to accuse falsely."
 "Diabolos" is used to describe someone who engages in slander, false accusations, or malicious talk.
 - Satan (שָּׁטַן) = a Hebrew word that means "adversary" or "accuser." It is derived from the root "שָּׁטַן," which conveys the idea of opposition, accusation, or enmity.
 - When we testify falsely, we are engaged in spiritual warfare = BUT FROM THE WRONG SIDE!

How do we speak only truth? → Your version. → My version. → And then there is the TRUTH.

- James 3:5-6: "In the same way, the tongue is a small thing that makes grand speeches. But a tiny spark can set a great forest on fire. And among all the parts of the body, the tongue is a flame of fire. It is a whole world of wickedness, corrupting your entire body. It can set your whole life on fire, for it is set on fire by hell itself."
- Proverbs 18:21: "The tongue can bring death or life; those who love to talk will reap the consequences."

- 1. Control your tongue!

 Habitual liars...have so far veered from truth they don't even know they are anymore.
- 2. Stop listening to lies. → "If you feel like you have to take a shower after every convo..."
- 3. Think before you speak. -> Your words matter. Don't waste them. Helpful? Add value to the convo?
- 4. Avoid exaggeration & hyperbole. → I love to fish...avoid words like always, everyone, never. → Gold fish Pic
- 5. Fact check. Fact check. Fact check. → Social media is a breeding ground for UNTRUTHS.
- 6. Check your motives. -> Am I trying to get someone to like me? Am I trying to get a job?
- 7. Admit when you don't know something. → "I dont know" or "ill find out." Instead of... "DL is the capital of CA."
- 8. CAUTION: If you dont have something nice to say...DONT SAY IT.→Not gossip, but unkind things.→U FAT!

Jesus transforms us through TRUTH.→Without TRUTH, we cannot be set free. But Truth can HURT, can't it?

- 1. Confess your sin to Jesus. → Jesus forgives...through CONFESSION. → Denial derails reconciliation...
- 2. Align your life with Jesus. → John 14:6 → Align your life to TRUTH...and you will align your life to Jesus.
- 3. Build your life on the teachings of Jesus. → Mt. 7:24-27 → Who does Jesus say that i am?
- 4. SHARE JESUS with others!→Give others access to the Truth that you have discovered.

→When we speak only truth, we contribute to a society built on a solid foundation.

TEACHING NUGGETS:

Why commandments? What is the purpose of the Law?

- 1. **Revealing God's Holiness**: Exodus 20:7-8 (NLT) "You must not misuse the name of the Lord your God. The Lord will not let you go unpunished if you misuse his name. Remember to observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy."
- 2. **Establishing God's Covenant**: Exodus 34:28 (NLT) "Moses remained there on the mountain with the Lord forty days and forty nights. In all that time, he ate no bread and drank no water. And the Lord wrote the terms of the covenant—the Ten Commandments—on the stone tablets."
- 3. **Guiding Moral and Ethical Behavior**: Exodus 20:12 (NLT) "Honor your father and mother. Then you will live a long, full life in the land the Lord your God is giving you."
- 4. **Maintaining Social Order**: Exodus 21:23-25 (NLT) "But if there is further injury, the punishment must match the injury: a life for a life, an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth, a hand for a hand, a foot for a foot."
- 5. Revealing God's Will: Psalm 119:105 (NLT) "Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path."
- 6. **Teaching Love and Compassion**: Leviticus 19:18 (NLT) "Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against a fellow Israelite, but love your neighbor as yourself. I am the Lord."
- 7. **Revealing Humanity's Sinfulness**: Romans 3:20 (NLT) "For no one can ever be made right with God by doing what the law commands. The law simply shows us how sinful we are."
- 8. **Pointing to Christ**: Galatians 3:24 (NLT) "Let me put it another way. The law was our guardian until Christ came; it protected us until we could be made right with God through faith."

Who are we partnering with when we slander someone?

- 3 "You must not have any other god but me.
- 4 "You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind or an image of anything in the heavens or on the earth or in the sea. 5 You must not bow down to them or worship them, for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God who will not tolerate your affection for any other gods. I lay the sins of the parents upon their children; the entire family is affected—even children in the third and fourth generations of those who reject me. 6 But I lavish unfailing love for a thousand generations on those who love me and obey my commands.
- 7 "You must not misuse the name of the Lord your God. The Lord will not let you go unpunished if you misuse his name. 8 "Remember to observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. 9 You have six days each week for your ordinary work, 10 but the seventh day is a Sabbath day of rest dedicated to the Lord your God. On that day no one in your household may do any work. This includes you, your sons and daughters, your male and female servants, your livestock, and any foreigners living among you. 11 For in six days the Lord made the heavens, the earth, the sea, and everything in them; but on the seventh day he rested. That is why the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and set it apart as holy.
- 12 "Honor your father and mother. Then you will live a long, full life in the land the Lord your God is giving you.
- 13 "You must not murder.
- 14 "You must not commit adultery.
- 15 "You must not steal.
- 16 "You must not testify falsely against your neighbor.
- 17 "You must not covet your neighbor's house. You must not covet your neighbor's wife, male or female servant, ox or donkey, or anything else that belongs to your neighbor."
