TEXT: LUKE 14:25-33



25 Large crowds were traveling with Jesus, and turning to them he said: 26 "If anyone comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even their own life—such a person cannot be my disciple. 27 And whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple.

²⁸ "Suppose one of you wants to build a tower. Won't you first sit down and estimate the cost to see if you have enough money to complete it? ²⁹ For if you lay the foundation and are not able to finish it, everyone who sees it will ridicule you, ³⁰ saying, 'This person began to build and wasn't able to finish.'

31 "Or suppose a king is about to go to war against another king. Won't he first sit down and consider whether he is able with ten thousand men to oppose the one coming against him with twenty thousand? 32 If he is not able, he will send a delegation while the other is still a long way off and will ask for terms of peace. 33 In the same way, those of you who do not give up everything you have cannot be my disciples.

BOTTOM LINE



Truth for today:

- 1. Following Jesus requires <u>intention</u>, not <u>impulse</u>.
- 2. Cutting corners **now** invites collapse **later**.
- 3. You cannot follow Jesus <u>halfway</u> and expect to experience an <u>abundant</u> life.

I. Measure **Twice**, Cut **Once**.

- Following Jesus is not impulsive. It's an investment.
- Depth requires daily <u>decisions</u>, not temporary <u>inspiration</u>.
- You can't build what <u>lasts</u> if you don't <u>slow</u> down long enough to count the cost.

II. Don't Cut Corners.

Our culture says that self-<u>fulfillment</u> is the ultimate goal. Jesus says, an <u>abundant</u>

- life doesn't come from self-fulfillment, but from self-denial.
- Cutting corners produces quick <u>progress</u> but unstable <u>results</u>.
- Obedience is the reinforcement that keeps your spiritual structure standing.

III. Begin with the end in mind.

- Jesus is not calling for <u>poverty</u>. He is calling for <u>priority</u>.
- Disciples don't live for <u>now</u>. They live for <u>next</u>.
- You cannot build a <u>forever</u> life with a temporary <u>mindset</u>.
