## 6 Ecclesiology

**Definition of the Church** *Ekklesia*:

Concerning the third point, it is known that the Church is catholic, that is, universal, first with respect to place, because it is throughout the entire world... Secondly, the Church is universal with respect to the condition of people, because no one is rejected... Thirdly, it is universal with respect to time, because the Church began from the time of Abel and will last to the end of the world. Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274)

## Eph 3:16-19
