

 - Always cooperate, never compete
 - Seek to build God's CHURCH locally and abroad
 - Plant new churches as God leads locally and abroad

Kingdom People

- Are citizens of heaven (Phil. 3:20)
 - Concerned about Christ's kingdom more than our own...
 - Personally
 - Nationally
 - Economically
 - Understand our identity and worth based on His creation mandates...
 - Sexual identity
 - Self-worth and the worth of others
 - Ethnically/Racially
 - Socio-economically
 - Dependence/need

Kingdom Purpose

- Mission Enablement
 - Beginning in 2023, 10% of operating budget will be allocated to local and foreign missional engagement and assisting in "sending".
 - Goal to grow by 2% per year until we reach 20% of budget.
- Local
 - Use resources to provide aid to those in need in the Bergheim community, preferably through a BCF mentor family.
 - Personal evangelism and commitment to pray for at least one person in your life to lead to Christ.
 - Regular service in an existing local ministry.

Kingdom Purpose cont'd

- Foreign Partners
 - Engage in strategic partnerships that engage the "unreached" of the world.
 - Partner with "sister churches" who align theologically and strategically, providing human and capital resources for kingdom work.
 - Partner with the purpose of a 2-way blessing.
- Mission Trips
 - Establish annual mission trips, preferably with existing partner churches or organizations that provide an opportunity for BCF members to use their gifts and abilities to bless a ministry in need (evangelism, medical, labor, special projects, etc).

Kingdom Purpose cont'd

- Every member has a personal commitment to the missional DNA of the church, whether it is through a church-sponsored effort or not.
 - How has God gifted you?
 - What circles has he placed you in?
 - How can you be mission-minded in these areas?
- The church is a resource, not a gatekeeper.

BCF Leadership Structure

- Interim leadership team:
 - Eric (BCF), John Free and Stuart Head (Currey Creek), Jared Patrick (The Bridge Fellowship)
- Elders:
 - Appointed elders (men), with a minimum of three, who are qualified according to 1 Tim. 3:1-7 & Titus 1:5-9.
 - BCF pastor is "first among equals" within the elders, not the CEO. He has one vote.
 - Elders are the decision-making group for the church but are primarily concerned with the spiritual welfare of the church (prayer and pastoral care).

BCF Leadership Structure cont'd

- Elder Selection:
 - Selected by existing elders based upon biblical qualifications as well as their character, competency, and chemistry attributes
 - Must be affirmed by the congregation
- Leadership Team
 - Men and women who meet with the elders to give insights, and often have a vested interest in the community or one of the ministries of the church.
 - Spiritually mature people whose lives reflect a close walk with Jesus
 - Advisory role only. Elders make final determinations.



- Community Engagement
 - Getting to know the community
 - Space for lingering and gathering
 - Welcome to all
- Ministry Usage
 - Meeting space for youth, Bible studies, office staff, etc
 - Food as a means of ministry to the school(s) and the needy

The Cup @ Bergheim

- Managed by a leadership team
- Answers to the BCF elders
- Proceeds go to BCF ministries (determined by elders)
- Combination of FT workers and BCF volunteers
- Operated with excellence, for the glory of God!

BCF Ministries (at launch)

• BCF Kids

- Sunday morning offering for nursery through 5th grade (space and volunteers permitting)
 - Teaching from the Bible
 - Songs that exalt God and teach biblically-accurate truths
 - Staffed by vetted (references and background checks) members who love the Lord and love working with children, and who have been a member for at least 6 months
 - May be offered during the whole adult worship time, or may be a part of service for a time then dismissed
 - Security tags and building monitors for safety

BCF Ministries (at launch)

• BCF Students

- Mid-week small group ministry for middle and HS students
 - Held at The Cup (while closed to the public)
 - Small group Bible study format with activities to build relationships
 - Worship
 - HS one night, MS another
 - Leaders are trained and vetted as per BCF Kids
 - Security provided

BCF Ministries (at launch)

• BCF Groups

- Home-based groups for Bible study and discipleship
- Multigenerational composition
- Sermon-based curriculum
- Bi-weekly frequency
- Missional component
- Undergirded in prayer

BCF Core Beliefs

- We commit to agree on the core:
 - Trinity (God the Father, Jesus the Son, the Holy Spirit)
 - Salvation by grace through faith in Jesus...a gift from God
 - The Bible as the sole authority, and inerrant
- We agree to disagree on the tertiary (ie, end times)
- We strive for unity despite preferences (ie, worship style)
